

Where is Your Faith?  
Luke 8:22-25; 40-55

Faith is the key to our lifelong journey of following Jesus in a genuine heart felt relationship. I believe Jesus cares about our faith and is willing to help us develop it if we ask Him.

In Luke chapter 8 there are 3 stories where Jesus mentions people's faith.

Take a moment to read them and center your discussion around the way Jesus describes faith in these verses.

- 1) In Luke 8:25, Jesus asks the disciples "Where is your faith?" Have you have gone through a "crisis of faith" moment in your life? How did you choose to have faith in that circumstance?
- 2) IN Luke 8:25, The Disciples asked, "Who is this? He commands even the winds and the waves to obey Him." ... Who is Jesus to you in the midst of the difficult circumstances you have faced? What is Jesus teaching you about who He is?
- 3) In Luke 8:45 ... Jesus asked, "Who touched me?" He noticed the woman's faith. Jesus notices our faith will we take the risk to take action on what we believe. Do you have a moment of decision like that in you journey?
- 4) In Luke 8:50 ... Jesus said to Jairus, "Don't be afraid; just believe ..."  
Is there something you are continuing to believe in Him for ... in spite of doubts or "Death of a vision" in you life?
