READ THE FOCAL PASSAGE

Read Acts 4:5-12 aloud.

Mark every reference to power, name, Jesus, resurrection, stone, and salvation.

What does the council’s question reveal about authorization?



FOCUS TEXT • ACTS 4:5-12

Matthew 28:18-20: Jesus possesses all authority and sends His disciples.

John 16:13-14: The Holy Ghost glorifies Jesus.

Psalm 118:22: Human rejection is overturned by God’s cornerstone verdict.

Acts 4:12: Salvation is in no other name.



REFLECT AND RESPOND

Where does pressure make naming Jesus feel costly?

How does Peter model prepared dependence on the Holy Ghost?

What does the cornerstone reveal about human and divine verdicts?

Write a one-sentence witness centered on Jesus.

FORWARD & HIGHER

Forward does not mean unopposed. Higher means deeper surrender. Together means we do not interpret pressure alone.
