







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



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In 2021, there were 49 OD visits to the county hospitals. Of those 39% were uninsured (selfpay), 20% were private insurance, and Medicaid/Medicare made up 35%.

Conclusion of ED data:

In 2021 there were a total of 49 non-fatal opioid related overdoses that averages to 4 overdoses per month. The month of September holds the highest incidence rate due to a spike in cases. Demographically cases are seen most often in males (61%) who are between the age of 25-44 (57%) that live in the larger populated cities/municipalities and are uninsured/self-pay (39%).







Responses

In 2021, EMS responded to **62 opioid overdoses**. The first graph displays by date and the second graph shows how many calls were made and responded to by month. On average there are about 5 calls per month that EMS responds to.




EMS data lags by a month or two, therefore the data may change slightly for the ending months of the year.



EMS: Opioid Overdose Responses by Age

Of the 62 overdoses responded to 27 (52%) were young adults (age 25-44). In the young adult age group those who were 43 years old made up 19% of that total.





Where the OD happened VS where the patient lives:

Of the 62 OD response calls, Leland, Supply, and Shallotte had the highest number. These residents resided primarily in the Leland area or outside of the County. Holden and Ocean Isle Beach areas held the next highest for the county.
