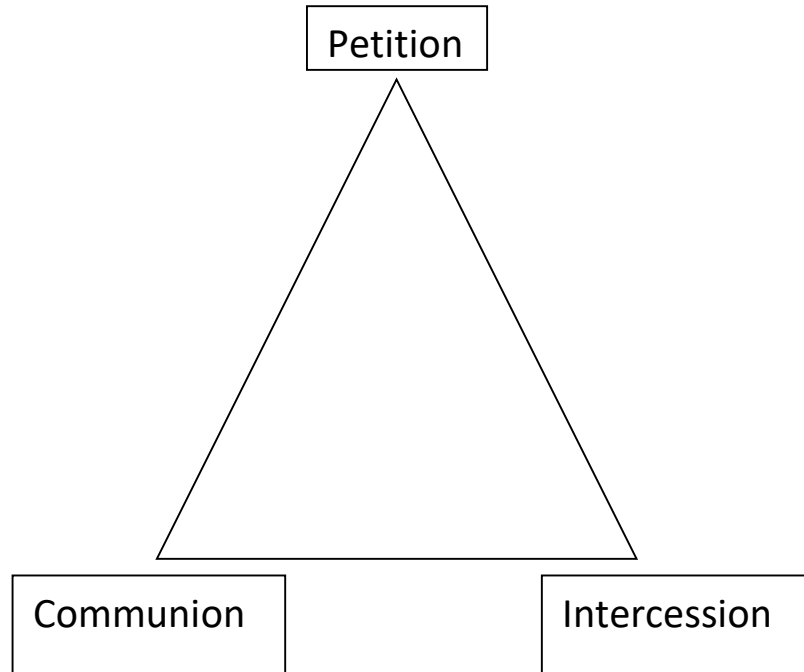


Three-Sided Prayer



- Petition: Requests for ourselves, prayer for ourselves to be sensitive to ministry opportunities, pray for the Holy Spirit to cleanse us and reveal the truth about us – how God sees us. Phil 4:6
- Communion: Praise, loving on God, soaking in His presence
- Intercession: Prayer for the needs of others, pray for the people God will bring to you to disciple

From the Welsh Revival: BEND ME: 1) Confess all known sins, 2) Remove anything in my life that is in doubt or I am unsure of, 3) OBEY the Holy Spirit instantly, and 4) Publicly Confess faith

Being a disciple is, at the core, about walking in a spirit of circumcision. Circumcision is about giving one's most intimate part to God. Circumcision is about bleeding and marking the most intimate place in our soul as belonging to God. The secret place – intimate place – between us and the Lord. It is about obedience.

Disciples Making Disciples

Scriptures for Week 3 (CSB translation):

Lamentations 3:40 "Let's examine and probe our ways, and turn back to the Lord."

1 Cor 11:28 "Let a person examine himself, in this way let him eat the bread and drink from the cup."

Gal 6:4 "Let each person examine his own work, and then he can take pride in himself alone, and not compare himself with someone else."

2 Cor 13:5 "Test yourselves to see if you are in the faith. Examine yourselves. Or do you yourselves not recognize that Jesus Christ is in you?"

Deut 6:4-9 "Listen, Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. These words that I am giving you today are to be in your heart. Repeat them to your children. Talk about them when you sit in your house and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Bind them as a sign on your house and on your city gates."

1 Cor 8:6 "For us there is one God, the Father. All things are from him, and we exist for him. And there is one Lord, Jesus Christ. All things are through him, and we exist through him."

"Take up my yoke and learn from me, because I am lowly and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls." (Matt 11:29)

1 Peter 3:15-16 "...but in your hearts regard Christ the Lord as holy, ready at any time to give a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you. Yet do this with gentleness and reverence, keeping a clear conscience, so that when you are accused, those who disparage your good conduct in Christ will be put to shame."

Matt 3:15 "Jesus answered him, "Allow it for now, because this is the way for us to fulfill all righteousness." Then John allowed him to be baptized."

1 Thess 5:22 (KJV) Abstain from all appearance of evil.

NIV: reject every kind of evil.

ESV: Abstain from every form of evil.

NASB: abstain from every form of evil.

NLT: Stay away from every kind of evil.

CSB: Stay away from every kind of evil.

1 Cor 10:12 "So, whoever thinks he stands must be careful not to fall."

Eph 5:15-16 "Pay careful attention, then, to how you walk – not as unwise people but as wise – making the most of the time, because the days are evil.

1 Cor 8:9 "But be careful that this right of yours in no way becomes a stumbling block to the weak."

Disciples Making Disciples

Luke 5:37-39 “And no one puts new wine into old wineskins. Otherwise, the new wine will burst the skins, it will spill, and the skins will be ruined. No, new wine is put into fresh wineskins. And no one, after drinking old wine, wants new, because he says, The old is better.

Ephesians 4: 13-16 And he himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, to build up the body of Christ, until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of God’s Son, growing into maturity with a stature measured by Christ’s fullness. Then we will no longer be little children, tossed by the waves and blown around by every wind of teaching, by human cunning with cleverness in the techniques of deceit. But speaking the truth in love, let us grow in every way into him who is the head – Christ. From him the whole body, fitted and knit together by every supporting ligament, promotes the growth of the body for building itself up in love by the proper working of each individual part.
