Romans 8:12-17 So then, brothers and sisters, we are not obligated to the flesh to live according to the flesh, because if you live according to the flesh, you are going to die. But if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. For all those led by God's Spirit are God's sons. For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear. Instead, you received the Spirit of adoption, by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father!" The Spirit himself testifies together with our spirit that we are God's children, and if children, also heirs – heirs of God and coheirs with Christ – if indeed we suffer with him so that we may also be glorified with him.

Romans 12:1-2 Therefore, brothers and sisters, in view of the mercies of God, I urge you to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God; this is your true worship. Do not be conformed to this age, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may discern what is the good, pleasing, and perfect will of God.

Romans 14:7-8 For none of us lives for himself, and no one dies for himself. If we live, we live for the Lord; and if we die, we die for the Lord. Therefore, whether we live or die, we belong to the Lord.

2 Corinthians 4:7-12 Now we have this treasure in clay jars, so that this extraordinary power may be from God and not from us. We are afflicted in every way but not crushed; we are perplexed but not in despair; we are persecuted but not abandoned; we are struck down but not destroyed. We always carry the death of Jesus in our body, so that the life of Jesus may also be displayed in our body. For we who live are always being given over to death for Jesus' sake, so that Jesus' life may also be displayed in our mortal flesh. So then, death is at work in us, but life in you.

2 Corinthians 5:15 And he died for all so that those who live should no longer live for themselves, but for the one who died for them and was raised.

Week 3 Challenges:

Day 15, Part 1: Challenge: The Live Dead initiative is all about dying to self. Do you know who you are in Christ? Do you realize that no one can take that away from you? Knowing that you are a son or daughter of God, are you willing to put it all down for advancing the gospel? Practice serving. Look for ways to serve with purpose. Let service become a part of your personality. Grab a broom, clean a toilet, help a stranger, lay down your priorities and seek God's. Live Dead is not about you. It's about them—the lost.

Day 15, Part 2: As you continue in the Live Dead Challenge, daily listen to the Lord of the Harvest? Is He calling you to live Red, Green, or White? How can you bend your will to help our church become missional in this community?

Day 17: Challenge: As you did your Bible reading today, what questions did you ask about what the text is saying? What questions do you believe God, through the Word, was asking of you? What did the two-edged sword pierce?

Day 20: Challenge: List three people whose death would profoundly affect you. Now, go before the Lord in prayer about how you would react if each of those people died. What would it affect? What would it change? Do you know Him enough to know you can trust Him, even with the pain of life? Would you continue to obey Him no matter the cost? Do you trust in His goodness? Will you share in His sufferings?
