



Discipleship Guide Acts 16

This guide was created to help you engage with the book of Acts and create deeper engagement with our worship services. Each week this guide will encourage you to reflect on two primary questions using the framework of Up (with God), In (with church) and Out (with neighbors). As we use this guide to reflect on the scriptures and your relationship with God, each other and your neighbors, consider pausing for a moment in quiet before jumping into the questions.

Weekly Questions:

- How is God getting my attention? For help, think about these areas:
 - How are you living up with God?
 - How are you living in community with other followers of Jesus?
 - How are you living out on mission with your neighbors?
- What are you going to do about it?

Acts 16 Questions:

Politics, religion, leaders and powers all around us try to turn people into products that can be bought and sold.

- Why is it important to pay attention to the way people try to sell us a way of life that may not point us to Jesus?
- What can you do when you realize that you are connected to something that doesn't help you follow Jesus?

Hospitality is a hinge value that helps us to see one another and our neighbors with hope and without judgment.

- Can you describe a time when someone showed you costly hospitality?
- How can you practice a costly hospitality this week?

Hospitality helps us to experience freedom and see what love looks like in public.

- How can you measure the quantity and quality of your hospitality this week in your relationships?

For our kids (and adults too!): How can you try to imagine what it is like to be in some else's shoes this week?

After reflection, what are you going to do about what you learned this week?
