



Discipleship Guide Acts 18

This guide was created to help you engage with the book of Acts and create deeper engagement with our worship services. Each week this guide will encourage you to reflect on two primary questions using the framework of Up (with God), In (with church) and Out (with neighbors). As we use this guide to reflect on the scriptures and your relationship with God, each other and your neighbors, consider pausing for a moment in quiet before jumping into the questions.

Weekly Questions:

- How is God getting my attention? For help, think about these areas:
 - How are you living up with God?
 - How are you living in community with other followers of Jesus?
 - How are you living out on mission with your neighbors?
- What are you going to do about it?

Acts 18 Questions:

Our relationships thrive when we work together with a common purpose or in the Christian faith, a common mission. Explore Paul, Priscilla and Aquila's relationship.

- Which relationships do you have where you work together towards a common mission?
- Why do you think relationships thrive when people work together?

When we support each other, working towards a common mission, our relationships thrive. Explore Paul, Priscilla, Aquila, Silas and Timothy's relationship.

- Which relationships do you have where you support each other?
- What are some characteristics of these supportive relationships?

When we guide each other, our relationships thrive. Explore Apollos, Priscilla and Aquila's relationship.

- In your relationships who are you guiding? Who is guiding you? Is it mission focused?
- What are some characteristics of a relationship where "guiding each other" is central?

For our kids (and adults too!): Share a story about a relationship with another person, your church, God, or your community that is thriving.

After reflection, what are you going to do about what you learned this week?
