



Discipleship Guide Live Generously Resources Acts 2:42-47

This guide is an invitation to follow Jesus with greater purpose and hope. It will help you to explore the scriptures and challenge you to live out your faith. Each week we'd love for you to think about how you relate: **Up** (with God), **In** (with church) and **Out** (with neighbors).

Weekly Questions:

- How is God getting my attention? For help, think about these areas:
 - How are you living up with God?
 - How are you living in community with other followers of Jesus?
 - How are you living out on mission with your neighbors?
- What are you going to do about it?

Read Acts 2:42-47

- How would you define generosity? Can you describe a time someone was generous with you? Can you describe a time you were generous with someone else?
- Can you describe a time when God was generous with you?
- In this scripture, what do they do together and share together as the early church? List them out. What sticks out? What surprises you? What challenges you?
- Why is it helpful to be devoted to shared teaching and learning? What are some of the distractions in our life that make it difficult to have shared learning?
- What does it mean to have a fellowship of believers together? What are challenges to living in fellowship together?
- Why is breaking bread (i.e. sharing communion together) so important? How does this help us remember Jesus?
- Why is prayer important? What are the ways you like to be prayed for? How do you like to pray for others?
- What other things did the early church share together? How would you know what would be helpful to share?
- What resources is God inviting you to share for the sake of others? What resources might God be asking our church to share with others?

After reflection, what are you going to do about what you learned this week?
