

PAUL'S APPEAL TO THE BELIEVER"

2 Corinthians 6:1 (HSBC) Working together with Him, we also appeal to you, "Don't receive God's grace in vain."

- **Working together with Christ.**

Matthew 28:20 (NKJV) teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, *even* to the end of the age." Amen.

- **Understanding the price of grace.**

1 Peter 1:19–21 HCSB) But with the precious blood of Christ, like that of a lamb without defect or blemish. He was chosen before the foundation of the world but was revealed at the end of the times for you who through Him are believers in God, who raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory, so that your faith and hope are in God.

2 Corinthians 6:2 HSBC) For He says:

I heard you in an acceptable time,
and I helped you in the day of salvation.

Look, now is the acceptable time; now is the day of salvation.

- **Salvation is a discipline**

Philippians 2:12–13 (NKJV) Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and

trembling; ¹³ for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for *His* good pleasure.

2 Corinthians 6:3 (AMPC) We give no opportunity for stumbling to anyone, so that the ministry will not be blamed.

- **Ministry should not be a roadblock!
(A Spiritual Barricade)**

Mathew 23:14–15 (NKJV) Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you devour widows' houses, and for a pretense make long prayers. Therefore you will receive greater condemnation.

¹⁵ "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you travel land and sea to win one proselyte, and when he is won, you make him twice as much a son of hell as yourselves.

James 3:2–3 (CEB) We all make mistakes often, but those who don't make mistakes with their words have reached full maturity. Like a bridled horse, they can control themselves entirely.

When we bridle horses and put bits in their mouths to lead them wherever we want, we can control their whole bodies.

FC Kid's Bible Verse:

Jesus teaches us to be careful when dealing with people in the church who don't belong, comparing them to weeds in a garden. Instead of trying to remove them, we should focus on producing good fruit and leave judgment to God. Matthew 13:40-41 reminds us that God will separate the weeds from the good plants at the end of the age. Our role is to love one another and trust God's judgment.

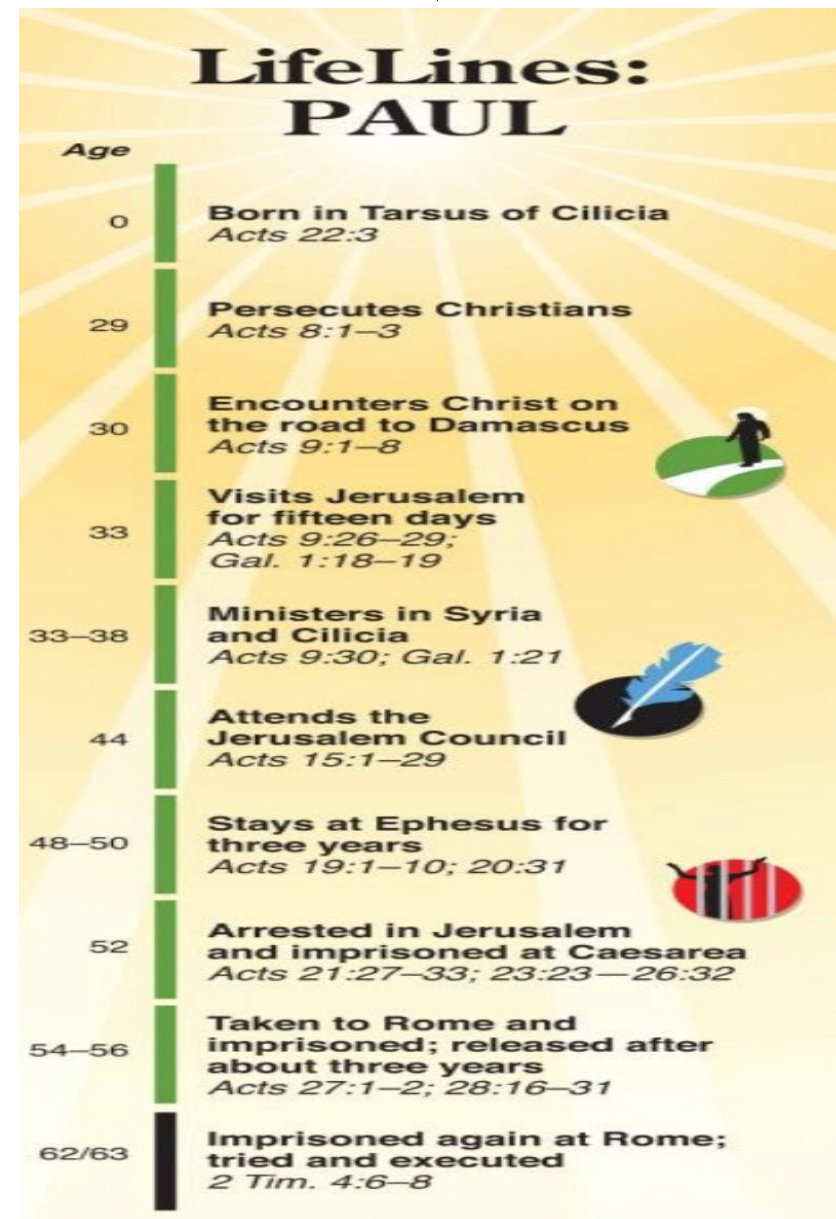
