

## ACTS 2:42/ TITUS 2 QUESTIONS

**“And they *continued steadfastly* in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers.”** as explained in (Acts 2:46) **“And *continuing daily* with one accord in the temple (corporate Sunday/Wednesday gatherings at HCF), and breaking bread from house to house (Acts 2:42 home fellowships), they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart.”**

Resulting in (Acts 2:47) **“ . . . and the Lord added to the church *daily* those who were being saved.”**

To be used in one-on-one, group, or family settings. We encourage the enjoyment of a meal or refreshments together (**breaking of bread**), spiritual conversation (**fellowship**), time discussing how the **Word** applies to our lives, and time of **praying** together during these simple gatherings.

Simply do life as believers should, and invite others to join you.

#### o APPLICATIONS QUESTIONS FROM BIBLE STUDIES:

1. How does it affect you personally to consider the fact that God wants to communicate with you His creation through “The Word”?
2. First in (Vs 1-5) we saw “The Word(Jesus) as Creator” and it answered one important question for us, “Is there a God?” Share with each other how you see the light of God in creation around you and in you. Review and discuss (Acts 17:23-25) in light of this.
3. Secondly in (Vs 6-13) we looked at “The Word in His Creation”. Answering the question for us “Can God be known”? Since Jesus made God “touchable” in a knowing relationship, how is your own personal relationship with Christ? Have you received Him personally, and what does that look like for you on a daily basis?
4. Thirdly in (Vs 14-18) we looked at “The Word beheld”. This answered for us the question, “What is God like”. Share some false ideas that you have had about God in the past, and how realizing Jesus is God's perfect expression of who He is to man changes those perspectives?
