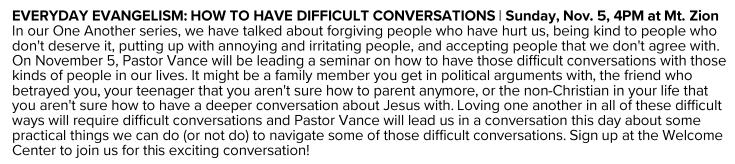
AWANA & RENU YOUTH COSTUME PARTY | Wednesday, October 25
