August 4, 2024 | Pastor Daniel Wellington | Matthew 21:23-46

Main Idea: Show your faith to be genuine through reflection, repentance, and reverence.

- 1. Reflect your beliefs
- 2. <u>Repent</u> frequently
- 3. <u>Revere</u> God alone

Questions for reflection/discussion:

- 1. Take a belief and action inventory. Are your actions direct results of your Christian beliefs?
- 2. How can you implement a rhythm of repentance into your life?
- 3. Who are some people that you may need to show more compassion to and less anger? What are some specific ways you can do that?
- 4. What are some things that you may give too much consideration to and that keep you from revering God alone?
- 5. Read and reflect on Galatians 1:10.
