- 1. Have Mary stoned
- 2. Disgrace her
- 3. Divorce quietly

Matthew 1:20-23 | God shows up in Joseph's confusion

Matthew 1:24-25 | Joseph demonstrates faith in the face of doubt

What you should learn about faith from Joseph

- Faith is not about belief, it is about trust
- Faith is not about reason or rationale, it is about relationship
- Faith involves not just the brain, but also the feet
- Faith involves not just beliefs, but how you live
- Faith doesn't remove doubt, it sets direction
