Christmas is a season of giving in remembrance of what God has given to us in the gift of His son Jesus. We celebrate at Mt. Zion by taking an offering to bless those around us in need. We will divide this year's offering in 3 ways. Locally, lunch debt is accruing significantly at some of our local schools in the midst of many families being out of work or not being paid right now, so we will again bless families at Fairbrook Elementary School in Beavercreek by paying down lunch debt at the school. Nationally, our newly adopted church plant, Rosemont Christian Church, just began a campaign to help them renovate and update their older church building. This is a great opportunity for us to begin our relationship with their church by blessing them in an unexpected way! Finally, the persecution of Christians has heightened around the world and yet the church is growing in many countries where Christianity is illegal. Global Catalytic Ministries was built to support church planters in nations where planting churches is illegal. They are training disciples currently in 71 countries, focusing on discipling former Muslims in hostile nations to go out and evangelize their neighbors and build the underground church in their own home countries.
