## The Gratitude Effect

"Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you."

1 Thessalonians 5:16–18 (ESV)

Gratitude is God's will for your life

To know Jesus, love Jesus, and make Jesus known

Rejoice always

We can rejoice always, because we already have everything that we need in Jesus

**Gratitude starts at the cross** 

"Let us be grateful, for receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken..."

Hebrews 12:28

When we truly accept and understand the gift of salvation, every other need diminishes

But nothing this world offers was ever meant to overshadow the gift of Jesus

Sometimes the thing ruining our gratitude is that we're staring at what we don't have instead of worshiping the One who already gave us everything

When Jesus is enough, gratitude overflows

To pray without ceasing

**Gratitude grows in prayer** 

They worshiped IN the chains

Gratitude is the faith that sees God before the miracle or EVEN if the miracle never happens

Your gratitude can be a witness

**Give thanks in ALL circumstances** 

Jesus gave thanks before suffering

Gratitude reveals where your trust is anchored

## We HAVE to pay attention

"Awake, O Sleeper, arise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you." Ephesians 5:14

But when we are paying ATTENTION and remain in a place of gratitude, our eyes are opened to the beauty that we already hold

"Offer to God a sacrifice of thanksgiving, and perform your vows to the Most High, and call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify me."

Psalm 50:14-15

Gratitude is simply our continual "yes" to His power
