

2 Corinthians 5

- What we do: Persuade

¹⁰ For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive what is due for what he has done in the body, whether good or evil.¹¹ Therefore, knowing the fear of the Lord, **we persuade others.**

- Accountability, *judgment*
- Justice and mercy through the cross
- Reward

God's heart honors the conscience of man. Hence, He uses **persuasion** not coercion.

Let the love of Christ control you: Lessons from Corinth

2 Corinthians 5

- How we do it: With integrity of motive

¹¹ But **what we are** is known to God, and I hope it is known also to your conscience. ¹² We are not commending ourselves to you again but giving you cause to boast about us, so that you may be able to answer those who boast about outward appearance and not about **what is in the heart**. ¹³ For if we are beside ourselves, it is for God; if we are in our right mind, it is for you.

- Before God
- Before others

- Love of Christ for those not by those he saves
- Controlling love: Constraining, channeling



- Christ's love is revealed in three ways
 - Christ died for all (types)
 - All (believers) have died with Christ
 - All (believers) now live for the risen Christ, not themselves
