# v. 1-2 God Preaches His Glory in The Skies Above

The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork. Day to day pours out speech, and night to night reveals knowledge.





#### Psalm 145:5-6

5 On the glorious splendor of your majesty, and on your wondrous works, I will meditate. 6 They shall speak of the might of your awesome deeds, and I will declare your greatness.

#### **Hebrews 13:15**

# All hear God's unheard voice






### Meditate on God's Glory in the Skies v.1-6
