1. The Source of Belief


vv. 25 - "...Unless I see in his hands the mark of the nails, and place my finger into the mark of the nails, and place my hand into his side, I will never believe..."

1. The Source of Belief

v. 25 – "..."Put your finger here, and see my hands; and put out your hand, and place it in my side. <u>Do not disbelieve, but believe</u>."
