

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

### The Lord hates those who get rich by injustice

"Come now, you rich, weep and howl for the miseries that are coming upon you. Your riches have rotted and your garments are moth-eaten. Your gold and silver have corroded, and their corrosion will be evidence against you and will eat your flesh like fire. You have laid up treasure in the last days. Behold, the wages of the laborers who mowed your fields, which you kept back by fraud, are crying out against you, and the cries of the harvesters have reached the ears of the Lord of hosts." - James 5:1-4

### First Group:

→ Those of you who may be <u>administering</u> this type of injustice.

- Take Heed
- Repent

**Ask yourself:** "Am I in integrity paying rightfully what is due?"



### Second Group:

→Those of you <u>under</u> this type of Injustice

"Be patient, therefore, brothers, until the coming of the Lord. See how the farmer waits for the precious fruit of the earth, being patient about it, until it receives the early and the late rains." -James 5:7

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## Principle #2: The Lord Loves those who Generous to the Poor.

"Whoever oppresses a poor man insults his Maker, but he who is generous to the needy honors him." Proverbs 14:31

## Principle #2: The Lord Loves those who Generous to the Poor.

"Whoever despises his neighbor is a sinner, but blessed is he who is generous to the poor." Proverbs 14:21

**Question**: What is at work in your heart that is causing you to withhold?



#### Questions for Reflection:

→ Do you view yourself as the ultimate manager of your finances, not the Lord?

- → Are you living with a scarcity mindset? Are you trusting your own understanding and provision, not the Lord as your provider?
- → What does your budget say you prioritize? Is there any room left for generosity?

"We want you to know, brothers, about the grace of God that has been given among the churches of Macedonia, for in a severe test of affliction, their abundance of joy and their extreme poverty have overflowed in a wealth of generosity on their part...

- Generosity is an overflow out of our intimacy with Jesus.
- Jesus says... "For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also"
- Our treasures are a reflection of what is going on in our hearts.

→ What is the work in your heart that is causing you to cling to your finances?

- → What is missing in your intimacy with Jesus that is causing a lack of generosity?
- → How should the abundance that Jesus has given you transform the way you give?

  - → Our understanding of Justice comes directly from the Lord and what he delights in.


"The Rock, his work is perfect, for all his ways are justice. A God of faithfulness and without iniquity, just and upright is he." -Deuteronomy 32:4
