Then the LORD said to Joshua, <sup>2</sup> "Say to the people of Israel, 'Appoint the cities of refuge, of which I spoke to you through Moses, <sup>3</sup> that the manslayer who strikes any person without intent or unknowingly may flee there. They shall be for you a refuge from the avenger of blood. <sup>4</sup> He shall flee to one of these cities and shall stand at the entrance of the gate of the city and explain his case to the elders of that city. Then they shall take him into the city and give him a place, and he shall remain with them...

...<sup>5</sup>And if the avenger of blood pursues him, they shall not give up the manslayer into his hand, because he struck his neighbor unknowingly, and did not hate him in the past. <sup>6</sup> And he shall remain in that city until he has stood before the congregation for judgment, until the death of him who is high priest at the time. Then the manslayer may return to his own town and his own home, to the town from which he fled."

- 3) Our Spiritual Needs




And for your lifeblood I will require a reckoning: from every beast I will require it and from man. From his fellow man I will require a reckoning for the life of man.



- 3. Cares for all human life regardless of nationality, ethnicity, religious belief, or citizenship status.



- 4. Doctrine of Carefulness consistent with a high regard for human life


















#### God's Concern for our Material Needs

Then the heads of the fathers' houses of the Levites came to Eleazar the priest and to Joshua the son of Nun and to the heads of the fathers' houses of the tribes of the people of Israel. <sup>2</sup> And they said to them at Shiloh in the land of Canaan, "The LORD commanded through Moses that we be given cities to dwell in, along with their pasturelands for our livestock." <sup>3</sup> So by command of the LORD the people of Israel gave to the Levites the following cities and pasturelands out of their inheritance.






