The incarnation radically changes our view of others:

Our culture tells us to view people as either obstacles or assets:

- Cut toxic people out of your life.

Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.



Jesus Became Poor



Jesus Prioritized the Powerless


The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor...
Luke 4:18


Blessed are you who are poor, for yours is the kingdom of God. Blessed are you who are hungry now, for you shall be satisfied. Luke 6:20-21





Jesus was a refugee in a foreign land.


