God Is Holy & We Are Not

Holy = set apart, distinct

"It covers all aspects of his transcendent greatness and moral perfection and thus is an attribute of all his attributes, pointing to the 'Godness' of God at every point. Every facet of God's nature and every aspect of his character may properly be spoken of as holy, just because it is his." J.I. Packer, *Concise Theology*

Core Aspect: God's perfect moral purity



God Is Holy & We Are Not

In the year that King Uzziah died I saw the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up; and the train of his robe filled the temple. Above him stood the seraphim. Each had six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. And one called to another and said:
