1. Preaching with Purpose (The Labour and Toil)

• 1 Thess 2:9 For you remember, brothers, our labor and toil: we worked night and day, that we might not be a burden to any of you, while we proclaimed to you the gospel of God.

Motive reflecting the heart of the shepherd

2. Practicing integrity (The Witness of Conduct Verse 10)

 1 Thess 2:10 You are witnesses, and God also, how holy and righteous and blameless was our conduct toward you believers."

 The Gospel's credibility shines through the righteous lives of its messengers and the hearers.

Integrity

Colossians 3:16

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

3. Promoting Growth (The Fatherly exhortation vs 11-12)

• 1 Thessalonians 2:11-12 For you know how, like a father with his children, we exhorted each one of you and encouraged you and charged you to walk in a manner worthy of God, who calls you into his own kingdom and glory.

 The purpose of preaching: to exhort, encourage and charge us to walk in a manner worthy of God

4. Power and effect of the Gospel (The reception and effect of the Gospel vs 13)

• 1 Thess 2:10 And we also thank God constantly[a] for this, that when you received the word of God, which you heard from us, you accepted it not as the word of men[b] but as what it really is, the word of God, which is at work in you believers.
