## >Tdy-wanta look at <u>1&2Thess's-READY?</u> I- HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

- A.In A16--P is on his 2<sup>nd</sup> miss jour'y MAP
  - 1. Respnding to a vision Gd gave him
  - 2.P & his team <u>cross w/Gpl</u> frm ASIA (Troas-Troy)to EUROPE fr vry 1<sup>st</sup> x
  - 3. They **begin** prchng Gspl in Philipi
  - 4. Many pple came to J/est'd church
- B. But evntually, they're <u>arrested</u>, <u>beaten</u> <u>jailed-& thn politely thrown outa twn</u>
- C. P left <u>Luke</u> behind to wrk w/yng chrch 1.While he/Silas/Tim move onto Thss
- D. Let's read hw thngs went in Thss-A17
  - 1.V. 1-Now they came to Ths'ca whre there was a Jewish synagogue
- ILLT: Thess has always had a sizeable

Jwsh pop frm before x of AP \*Tht is—until 1941

- \*In 1941—Nazi's took over the city & deported all 60K Jews to **Auswich**
- \*Where they were put to death

APPL: Tdy—less than 1000 Jsh ple in city

- 2.V.2-"& acc to P's custom, he went to Jsh ple 1st, & fr 3 Sabaths reasoned with thm frm the Scriptures..."
- 3. V. 3-"Explaining & giving evidence tht the Mes had to suffer & rise again from the dead, & saying, 'This J, whom I am proclaiming to U, IS the Messiah."
- 4. V. 4-"& some of the Jwsh pple were persuaded & joined Paul & Silas, along with a large number of Gdfearing Gentiles, & a number of the city's leading women."
- 5. V. 5-"The the (unblying)Jwsh pple became jealous & taking align some wicked min frm the mrktplace, thy formed a mob & went to Jason's house looking for Paul & Silas."

IL: P&his team stayng at Jason's house

6. V. 6-"& whn they did not find thm, they dragged Jason & some other blvr's before the <u>city\_authorities</u>"

IL: Gk wrd fr "city officials"=POLITARCHS
\*Until 150yrsago, wrd nvr fnd outsideB

\*So <u>crites of B</u> usd this as a key exple of B's <u>inaccuracy</u> & <u>unreliability</u>

\*In fact, to this day—we've nvr found the term "politarch" in any Gk lit

\*BUT...in last 150yrs—archaeolg's hve fnd 64 ocurrences of "POLITARCH" on *inscriptions* dug outa grnd

\*<u>Confirming</u>--tht at x of AP—Thess was ruled by <u>5 local magistrates</u> who had <u>unique title</u>: <u>politarchs</u>

APPL: So <u>all these cnt's--B's been rght & all the wrld's scholars</u> been <u>wrong!</u>

- <u>UKNW WHAT WE SAY</u>: "The more they dig out of the ground, the more the B proves to be right!"
  - 7. V. 6-" They dragged Jason & some othr blvr's bfore the *POLITARCHS* shouting, 'These men who have turned the world upside down

have come here too, & Jason has welcomed them into his home"

8. V. 7-"'& they are acting contrary to the laws of Caesar, saying tht there is anther gd, named Jesus."

#### **HEY-THEY GOT THE POINT—RIGHT??**

- 9. V.8-"& they stirred up the crowd & the Politarchs. & aftr Jason gave them a pledge, thy released him
- 10. V. 9-"Then the brethren immed'ly sent Paul (for his own safety) & Silas away by night to Berea." MAP

# 11. P's total time in Thss = 1 mnth [BUT THE STORY DOESN'T END THERE

E. V. 10-"Whn P & Silas arrived in Berea, they went to the Jewish synagogue.

#### ILST: SLIDE OF STEPS P PREACHED ON

- 1. V. 11-"Now these Jwsh pple were more noble-minded thn the Jews in Thess, & they receive the Word with great eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily, to see if wht P was saying was true."
- 2. V. 12-"Thrfre, many of thm blved ILLUT: B's telling us a huge truth here

\*Tllng us: any prsn who will examine the Scriptures w/an open mind

\*Tht prsn WILL end up believing tht JESUS IS THE MESSIAH

APPL: It's the only logical place a prsn <u>CAN</u> end up!

3.V.13-"But whn the (unblying)Jwsh ple in Thess found out tht the WOG was being preachd in Berea, they came *there* & bgan agitating & stirring up the crowds.

\*U get the picture—right?

- \*P's Jwsh enemies in Thess hated him so much...
- \*Tht just running him outa Thess wasn't good enuf for them
- \*They wanted to run him outa everywhere!

\*So they followd him to Berea!

4.V. 14-"The imed'ly(again fr safety) the brethren sent P to Athens by way of the sea, while Silas & Tim remained in Berea."

[OK--SO here we hve the hist'l events

#### II- LETTER TO THESSALONIAN CHCH

A.Aftr P arrived in Athns alone...he spent several weeks preaching there...& then moved on to Corinth--MAP

#### B. The year was 51 AD

- C. Soon aftrwrds(Acts 18:5)-"Silas & Tim arrived in Corinth"
- D. Tim told P tht the blvr's in Thess were suffering <u>terrible persecution</u> fr faith
- E. So P sent Tim back to Thess--to make sure their faith wasn't faltering--in the face of such heavy persecution
- F. 1 Th 3:2-"So I sent Tim back to U, to strengthen & encourage U as to yur faith, tht none of U shld be shaken by these sufferings...for indeed when I was there with U, I told U in advance tht we were going to suffer prscution, just as has happened, as U well know
- G. 1 Th 3:5-"Thus, I sent to find out abt yur faith; for I was afraid tht the Tempter might hve tempted U (ie, to abandon the faith) & thus our labor among U might've been in vain."
- H. V. 6-"But now, Tim has returned &

brot us the good news abt yur faith...

- J. V 7-"& so, evn in our suffring, we were encouraged, fr we really live, if U stand firm in the Lord"
- K. & so--this is why P wrote both ltrs to the Thess's—frm Crnth--52AD

  1.To commend them fr perseverance
  2. & to encourage thm to keep standing firm in the Lord
- L. 2 Thess 1:3-"We thank Gd fr U...&
  boast among Gd's churches abt yur
  prseverance & faith, in spite of the
  persecutions & trials U are enduring"
  1.2:15-"Thrfre, stand firm & hold to
  the truths U were taught by us,
  whether in person or by letter."
  - 3. 3:3-"Fr the Lrd is faithful, & He will strengthen & protect U."

#### III- SO WHAT?

- A.1 Ths 2:2(P)-"Aftr we'd already sufferd & been mistreated in Philipi, as U knw
- REM: arrested, beaten, jailed, thrwn outa we were still bold to speak the Wrd of Gd to U amid strong opposition..."
- B. 2:14-"Fr yur own cntrymn drove us

- out (of Thess) & tried to keep us frm speaking to the Gentiles thi they might be saved"
- C. 3:4-"Fr, in fact, when we were there w/U (in Thess), we kept telling U tht we would be persecuted, just as it has happened to U, as U well know"
- D. Phil 1:29(P)-"For it has been granted to us on Christ's behalf, not only to believe in Him, but also to suffer for His sake"
- E. J Himself said (Jn 15:20)-"Rem what I said to U: 'A servant is not greater than his master. If they persecuted Me, they will persecute U (if U stand up for Me!)...& these things they will do to U fr My sake, bec they do not know the One who sent Me"
- F. Paul makes it crystal clear...that...
  - 1. IF **WE** STAND UP FOR CHRIST...
  - 2. ANYWHERE...ANYTIME...ANYHOW
  - 3. WE'RE GONNA BE PERSECUTED...
    \*It MAY BE VERBALLY/PHYSCIALLY
    EMOTIONALLY/EVEN VIOLENTLY
    \*BUT WE'RE GONNA PAY A PRICE!

- 4. NOT BEC OF WHO <u>WE</u> ARE \*BUT BEC OF WHO <u>JESUS</u> IS
- 5. P:"We need to know this going in"
- 6. "& we need to expect nothing diff
- G. True of Thess's—but true to AP too!
- H. On his 1st miss journey...
  - 1.P was abused in Psidian Antioch
  - 2. Had his life threatened in Iconium
  - 3.Stoned & left for dead in Lystra
- J. SO FAR--on his 2<sup>nd</sup> miss journey...
  - 1.Been beaten & imprisned in Philipi
  - 2. Been run outa twn in Thess & Berea by mobs who wanted to kill him
  - 3. Been laughed outa twn in Athens
- K. & it's gonna get worse—latr P writes
- L. 2 Cr 11:23-"I've been beaten times w/out number, frequently in prison, often in danger of death."
  - 1.V. 24-"Five times from the Jews I received 39 lashes"
- ILLT: Seen **Passion**—imag'ne P's back??
  - 2. V. 25-"Three times I was beaten with rods(A 16 in **Philippi**); once I was stoned(A 14 in **Lystra**); three

times I was shipwrecked (A27); a nite& a day I've spent in the deep;

- M. Yet despite all this -- P kept going!
- N.  $\underline{\mathbf{QUESTION}} = \mathbf{WHY}$ ?
- O. A=P blieved smething so completely
  - 2. That it drove him to a level of commitment world rarely seen
  - 3. <u>Blved</u> tht—apart frm pers faith faith JC--no one will evr hve etr life or see the shores of hvn
  - 4.**BC**--this=wht B teaches w/out equiv
- P. Jn 3:36-"Whoevr blieves in the Son(JC) has eter life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see eter life"
- Q. Jn 14:6-"I am the Way, Truth & the Life--NO ONE comes to the Father (eter life/heaven) except thru Me"
- R. 1 Jn 5:11-"& this is the record--tht Gd has given us eter life, and this life is in His Son (JC). He who has the Son has eter life; he who does not have the Son of Gd does not have eter life"
- S. Acts 4:12-"Salv is fnd in **no one else**, fr there is no other name under hvn, (except J's) by whch we can be saved"

- T. P knew that pple are hopelessly lost wout JC ("no othr name undr hvn")
  - 1. Which is <u>WHY</u> he was so "driven" to keep telling pple ab JC
  - 2.Evn if it brot the mst heinous & brutal treatment imaginable on him

### [DO WE ALL SEE THIS???? GOOD!!]

- U. Bec—the only way...we as F'sOC...
  - 1. Are gna be wllng to live lke P lived
  - 3. Is if we <u>utterly blve wht P blieved</u>
- V. **REM**: Fr Satn to get us to nvr share J
  - 1.He doesn't hve to convince us tht J is not A WAY to heaven
- 2. He just needs to convince us tht J is not *THE ONLY* way to heaven W.But B says J=only way/so who gna blv? **CONCLUSION**
- >2 T 1:8-"Therefore, do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lrd...but join with me in suffering fr the Gospel"
- My hrt breaks fr us to tke P's wrds ser'sly
- >We can study B/ mem Scrip/ pray & fast
  - \*But if all of this doesn't result ...
  - \*In our being outspken witnesses fr J
  - \*Thn we missed the **WHOLE POINT!!**
