I-BACKGROUND

- A. The <u>city of Eph</u> was one of the most strategic cities in RE at x of AP-MAP
 - 1. The western half of Turkey made up the Rmn province = "ASIA"
 - 2. As U can see--Eph=its main seaport
 - 3. As such—Eph became the 3rd most impt city in REmp(Alex'a & Rome)
 - 4. At x of AP—Eph had a pop of 300K
 - 5. & it was a magnificent city—<u>SLIDE</u>

 *Theatre seated 25K—<u>SLIDE</u>

 *Temple to godess Diana(Atemis)

 tht-1 of "7Wonders"—SLIDE
- B. P finally got to Eph on his 3rdmiss jour

- & spent almst 3yrs there (53-56 AD)
- 1. Preaching Chrst/discipling blvr's
- 2. Reaching pple passing thru town
 *Who thn took Gspel back home
 *With remarkable results
- 3. Acts 19:10-"All who lived in Asia (1/2of Turkey) heard the word of the Lrd, both Jews & Gentiles"
- 4. This is hw the <u>othr 6 chrchs of Rev</u>

 2-3 were started-& <u>Colossae</u>--**MAP**

II- LET'S TALK AB P'S LETTR TO EPH'S

- A. Ephesians—along with the next 3 ltrs
 - 1. Philip's / Colossians / & Philemon...
- 2. Are referd to as "The Prison Ep's"

 B. SEE--after P left Eph in 56 AD...
 - 1.He went toJer(A21)-whre Jwsh mob tried to kill hm--& Rns arrested h m
 - 2. P spent 2 yrs in jail in Is(A 21-26)
 - 3. The he appealed his case to Caesar & was shipped to Rome(Acts 27)...
 - 4. Where he spent <u>2 more yrs</u> in jail (61-62AD) awaiting trial (Acts 28)
- C. It was <u>during this imprisonment in Rme</u> the P wrote the "<u>4 prison epistles</u>"
- E. IF U REM: we said tht P's ltrs to the

churches all follow a similar pattern 1.1^{st} section = theolog'l issues

2. 2nd section =prac'l Chr-life issues

III- 1st HALF & SEE WHT THELG TRUTH

- A.Many comentators miss the key thlog'l truth the AP is teaching us in ch's 1-3
- B. We <u>discover this truth</u> by noticing the <u>repeated contrast</u> betw "U" & "we"
 - 1. 1:12-"<u>We who were 1st</u> to hope in C *1:13-"In Him, <u>U also</u> believed"
 - 2. 2:1-"<u>U</u> were dead in yur trs's &sins *2:3-"<u>We also</u> used to live in the lusts of our flesh"
 - 3. 2:17-"& He came & preached peace to <u>U who were far away</u>, & peace to <u>US who were near</u>"

C. DO WE ALL SEE THIS CONTRAST?

- D. So Q: "Who is 'U'...& who is 'we/us'?"
- E. Well, P_answrs tht Q fr us:
 - 1. Eph 2:11-"Thrfore, remembr tht <u>U</u>, the Gentiles in the flesh, who are called 'Uncircumcision'."
 - 2. Eph 1:13-"<u>U also</u> trusted in Chrst aftr U heard the Gspl of yur salv"
 - 3. SO THE "U" = Gentile blvr's in I

- 4. Eph 1:12-"WE who ISTtrusted in Christ being to praise of His glory *Who were the 1stple to trust in J? *Well, of crse, they were Jwsh ple
- 7. <u>SO THE "WE</u>" = <u>Jewish blyr's in J</u>

 <u>F. OK—got who each group is??</u>

 [WATCH AS P MKES HIS THEOLOG PT]
- G. Eph 2:12-"Remmbr, tht U, the Gentiles in the flesh(before saved P says) U were separated frm Chrst, excluded from the commonwealth of Israel, strangers to Gd's cynants of promise, hvng no hope, & w/out Gd in the wrld
 - 1. <u>E 2:13</u>—"<u>U</u> were <u>far off (frm Gd</u>)"
- 2. E 2:19-"U were strangers & aliens (to all Gd's covenants & promises)" SAY: "So P's pt is to mke Gntiles feel bad? H. Eph 2:13-"BUT NOW—in CJ—U who
 - were formerly far off (Gent's) have been <u>brot near</u> by the blood of Chst" 1.V. 14-"Fr He (LJC)is our peace, who
 - has made both grps(J&G's)into 1"
 - 2. V. 15-"He made the 2 grps into one new man..reconciling thm both to Gd in one body thru the cross."

- 3. Eph 2:19-"So then, <u>U</u> (Gent's) are no longer strangers & aliens, but <u>U</u> are fellow citizens with all the saints (Jwsh & Gnt) & <u>equal</u> members of the household of Gd
- J. In P's day, this=revolutionary truth
 K. In P's day, the Jews despised Gntiles
 - 1. They called them "dogs"
 - 2. Thy sought to avoid all contact w/
 - 3. Acts 22(P speaking to Jews at Tem)
 - 4. Told thm wht hpned on Dam road
 - 5. V. 17(P)-"& whn I came bck to Jer, I was praying & the Lrd said, 'Mke haste & get out of Jer, bc they will not accept yur tstimny ab Mehere
 - 6. V. 21-"& Gd said to me, 'Go! For I will send U far away to the <u>Gntiles</u>
 - 7. V. 22-"& the crowd listed to P until this word (Gentiles), & then they raised their voices & said, 'Away with such a fellow from the earth! He shld not be allowed to live!"
- SAY: "Yea, but those were <u>non-blvg Jews</u>" L. <u>Sadly</u>—the prob wasn't limited to thm
 - 1. NT makes it clear...tht aftr Gntiles

began getting saved...

- 2.Mny <u>Ish blr's</u> discrminated ag thm ILLT-Whn Gd sent Ptr to Cornelius(A10)
 - *& Cornelius & whole fam came to J
 - *Acts 11:1-"Now the apostles & other Jwsh blvrs in Judea heard tht the Gntiles had received the Wrd of Gd
 - *V. 2-"So whn Ptr came to Jeru, they criticized him, saying, 'Why did U go to uncircumcised pple & eat with them?"
 - *After Ptr explained how these Gen's had trusted Cht--& HS fell on thm
 - *V. 18-"When they heard this, they were silenced"
- M. But even <u>aftr</u> Jwsh blvr's were forced to accept tht Gntiles cld come to Chst 1.Many--including even <u>Ptr/Barnabas</u>
 2.<u>Kept</u> seeing thm as "2nd class Chr's"
 - 3. Not fully equal with "Iwsh blvrs"
- ILLU: Gal 2:11(P)-"But when Ptr came to Antioch, I opposed him to his face, bec he stood condemned."
 - *V. 12-"Fr prior to the cming of some men frm James(<u>Jwsh blvr's frm Jer</u>)

Ptr wld eat wth the Gntile blvrs; but whn these men came, Ptr withdrew & separated himself frm Gentiles, fearing those of the circumcision."

- *V. 13-"& the rest of the Jwsh blvrs (there in Antioch) joined Ptr in his hypocrisy, so tht even Barnabas was carried away in their hypocrisy."
- N. SO CAN WE SEE—how P's declaration here in Bk of Eph's...
 - 1.Tht Gentile blvr's & Jwsh blvr's are completely equal in Christ...
 - 2. Tht they are (V. 2:19) "fellow citizens & equal members of the household of Gd"
 - 3. Hw <u>revolutionary</u> this was thlog'ly?
- O. This theolog'l truth is wht P refers to (in Eph ch 3) as the "mystery of the curh" -- tht no one knew until now 1.OT = clear tht the Gntles wld get to share in the blessings of Messiah
 - 2. Gen 12:3(to Ab)-"& ALL the fam's on earth will be blessed thru U"
 - 3. BUT the <u>"mystery of the church"</u> *Is tht Gd wld create a new entity

- *Called "the church"...
- *Whre <u>Gntile blvr's in Chst</u> wld be **EQUALin** evry way w/Jwh blr's
- 4. E3:3-"**By** revelation (directly frmJ) this mystery was mde knwn to me, which was not made knwn prev'sly
- 5. V.6-"Namely, tht the Gentiles are fellow-heirs &fellow-members of the body of Chst & fellow-partakers of Gd's prmises in Christ thru the Gospel."
- 6. GENTILE BLVR'S...BEING:
 - *Equal heirs...w/Jewish blvr's
 - *Equal members of the body of Chrst...w/Jewish blvr's
 - *<u>Equal</u> partakers of Gd's promises in Christ...w/<u>Jewish blvr's!!</u>
- IL: Tevye: this was unhrd of/unthnkable
 P.BUT this=no last-minute decisionby Gd
 1.Eph 3:11-"All this was in accordace
 with Gd's etrnal purpose which He
 purposed to do in JC our Lord"
- Q. <u>SUMMARIZE</u>: The theolog'l truth P lays out in Eph's fr us as Chr's to under 1.Gal 3:28-"In Chst, there <u>IS</u> no Jew

- or Gentile...fr we are all **one** in Chst
- 2. 1 Cor 12:13-"Fr by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body whether Jews or Gentiles...
- 3.**PT**-whn we meet anthr *true blvr inJ* *Earthly diff's no longer matter !! *Doesn't mattr what race we are

<u>/color/lang/culture/finances</u>

*Dsn't mttr if we hve **blonde** hair /brown/black/green/NO hair

*We're all brothrs/ sisters in Chst

*We're ALL... EQUAL...in Christ

IV- SO WHAT?

- A.Now—Bk of Eph's is "chocker-block full" of great Chr-life truth
- B. I mn--U cld spend <u>yrs</u> going thru it!
- C. But since we don't <u>hve</u> yrs--let's pick 1
- D. Eph 3:20-"Now to Hm, who by the pwr at wrk within us(HS), is able to do exceedingly abundantly more than we can ask or imagne--to Hm be glory
 - 1. Hey—I can *IMAGINE* a lot
 - 2. B says—<u>not</u> tht Gd can do <u>MORE</u>...
 - 3. Butexceedngly abundantly more
- E. Wht Gd claiming = He is **omnipotent**

- 1.Tht He can do whtever he wants/
 whenever he wants / however he
 wants/to whomever he wants/ for
 whyever reason he wants
- 2. Jer 32:27-"I am the Lrd, the Gd of all flesh. Is *anythng* too hard fr me?
- F. & bec Gd HAS this unlimited pwr...
 - 1. We as his F's shld approach every sit in life/challenge/obstacle...
 - 2. With <u>unlimited expectations</u>...
 - 3. Of what God can do & will do...
 - 4. Acc to His perfect will for our lives
- G.Jer 33:3-"Call unto Me, & I will answer; & I will show U great & mighty things tht U know not"
 - 1. "Expect Me to answer"
- 2. "Expect Me to do mghty thngs fr U IL: TOZER-"True faith is nvr found alone; it is always acompanied by expectation. The prsn who blieves the promises of Gd always expects to see thm fulfilled *"One charcteristic tht marks the avg Chr tdy is lack of expectation. Whn we pray, we don't expect anything

unusual to happen; consequently, nothing does."

APPL: Hw ab U, my Chr frnd? Hw abt me?

- *Do we have this "holy expectation"?
- *Do we <u>expect</u> Hm to "<u>answr when we</u> <u>call on Hm..& to do great & mghty</u> <u>things tht we know not</u>"?

*When we call on Him to:

- **Heal our broken relat'ships...
- **Convict pple of their need fr Ch
- **Open closed doors for us...
- **Give us favor in key pple's eyes
- **Clear impss-lkng obst's frm path
- **Provide for our earthly needs
- **Give us the strngth we need to resist sin & obey God
- **Do we expect Him to answer??
- *Whn we pray fr prkng space, expect
- *Whn pray ab lost keys..expct to find
- H. "Holy expctation" is not wishful thinkg
 - 1.It's the confident assurance tht whn I <u>call</u> on Gd, he's <u>gonna</u> <u>aswr in pwr</u>
 - 2. May not alwys be exctly wht I ask fr
 - 3. Will always be <u>exactly what I need</u> for godliness & true blessing in life

CONCLUSION

- >>>B calls us as Chr's to live a life tht's saturated with "holy expectation"
 - *Whn we've got a prmise lke Jer 33:3 "Call unto Me, & I will answr; & I will show U great & mighty things tht U know not"
 - *<u>& whn</u> we've got a Gd who Eph 3:20 "is able to do <u>exceedingly</u>

 <u>abundantly more</u> thn we can ask or imagine."
 - *If we believe Gd-no rsn we shldn't
