What changed in your life when you approached your daily life as a son or daughter instead of an orphan?● Ask "what does this teach us about God and ourselves?"<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ We learn in 1 John that we are "children"; not always fully understanding what we need to - what have you learned in this series that you had a "childish" idea about before?○ How does your perspective of sacrifice change when you learn that God does not "need" our sacrifices, but	<p>Pray</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Pray for each other's needs and requests. <p>Reflection/Challenge of the week</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Challenge: If your heart is not at rest, spend time in His presence.<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ How will you do this this week?
