FROM THE HEART OF PASTOR BULT

Early in his letter to them, The Apostle Paul tells the Romans why he is so pastorally driven to travel to Rome and be with them: "So that I can impart to you some spiritual gift to make you strong." And then he seems to catch himself. While this is true enough, it doesn't tell the whole story. Paul seems to realize he personally needs what the Lord has given the Romans just as much as they need what the Lord has given him. He continues: "That is, that you and I might be mutually encouraged by each other's faith- both yours and mine." This reminds us that God has built into his church a beautiful mutual interdependence. God has given you specific spiritual gifts that other people in the church need you to recognize, cultivate, and use. In the same way, he has given other people specific abilities and talents that you need them to harness, develop, and use. This is the way the Lord builds up his church. Many examples abound in the life of First Pres. One of these is the mutual sharpening of iron that takes place at the men's Bible study on Tuesday mornings in the Bridge Basement at 10:30. To grow spiritually, the church needs the gifts of pastors. But no less than pastors need the gifts of church members. I am so glad that I get to benefit from the unique gifts that God has entrusted to you!


