### From the Heart of Pastor Bryan Bult

The Apostle Paul writes to tell the Thessalonians that Christ 'died for us so that whether we are awake or asleep we might live with him. Therefore encourage one another and build one another up, just as you are doing.' Scripture is clear that salvation is full and free in Christ. For this we should be eternally grateful, because none of us could ever earn or deserve it. And scripture is just as clear that salvation carries with it implications for our lives. In other words, we are saved from sin and condemnation, but we are also saved for something. And that something, in this passage, is spelled out as the responsibility to encourage one another, and to build one another up. Even as he writes this instruction to the Thessalonians, he wants to assure them that he sees them doing these very things. Well, I see you doing those things too, and it greatly encourages me. I see an awful lot of mutual encouragement going on in our congregation. Encouragement can take many forms, from a written letter, to a kind word verbalized, or through supportive presence and offering a helping hand. I see all of these among our church family, and especially among you, our cherished seniors. I am grateful that as a result of Christ's death, you in turn are building your fellow believers up in the faith. It is a true sign the gospel has taken root in you.
