Some five years before his death, theologian and preacher, J. I. Packer, wrote a book about aging. He called it, Finishing Our Course with Joy: Guidelines from God for Engaging with Our Aging (Crossway, 2014). With his characteristic precision, Packer noted how Paul approached his own final years: seeking opportunities to invest in those who would outlive him; making the most of his maturity and wisdom (working smarter, not harder); with humility (as opposed to living pridefully); and with great intensity and zeal for the things that will last beyond the grave in eternity. It is a wonderful read but be prepared to be challenged! Joy, he tells us, comes to those who put Jesus first and others second and ourselves last. Not all Christians grow old gracefully and apart from heeding Packer's recommendation, we too are likely to succumb to becoming someone we do not wish to be.

Jesus, help me to finish the race strong and to make my life a testimony to your grace.
Lord, help me to rejoice in hard times trusting that trials will make me more like my Savior.
Lord, help me to live every day of my life victoriously and triumphantly knowing that you will never leave me nor forsake me. Amen
