

# Pure in Heart

Matthew 5:8

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## The P\_\_\_\_\_ : To S\_\_\_\_\_ God

Some in the Old Testament are said to “see God,” but only partially or through visions (Isaiah 6; cf. Exodus 24:9-11), theophanies (Genesis 18:1-8; Joshua 5:13-15), or in a veiled way (Exodus 33:18-23).

In the New Testament, we are told that no one sees God (John 1:18; 1 Tim 1:17; 6:16).

*God’s **invisibility** means that God’s total essence, all of his spiritual being, will never be able to be seen by us, yet God still shows himself to us partially in this age and more fully in the age to come. - Wayne Grudem*

The promise given to believers is that one day we will see God (Matthew 5:8; Revelation 21:22-22:5). When we see God, all unrighteousness will be eradicated from us (1 John 3:1-3)! Christians have historically called this the **Beatific Vision**.

## Two Ways to be Lost: L\_\_\_\_\_ and L\_\_\_\_\_

Way #1 - Resting in our own righteousness rather than resting in grace (Ephesians 2:8-10).

Way #2 - Using God’s grace as an excuse to continue in sin (Romans 6).

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*There are two ways to be your own Savior and Lord. One is by breaking all the moral laws and setting your own course, and one is by keeping all the moral laws and being very, very good. - Tim Keller*
