As we conclude our *This is the Bible* series this week, we're taking a second week to talk about the "bloody" Bible and looking specifically at sacrifices. Today's text says that Jesus' sacrifice "secured an eternal redemption" for us and "purifies our consciences" so that we might serve God. But how does this sacrifice compare to the sacrificial system in the Old Testament? Let's talk about it.

SACRIFICES

Hebrews 9:11-14 (page 1006; large print page 1193)

God's law and sacrifices are not obsolete, but God's people pervert the purpose of sacrifices if they think they can put God under obligation to them by giving them what He already owns. Sacrifices are not magic, automatically bending God to grant wishes. (Lutheran Study Bible, Psalm 50:8-9 notes)
