This is the second week of our *This is War* message series, where we're learning how to defend ourselves against Satan and his schemes. Today Pastor Chris is talking about how Satan is a deceiver, the father of lies. And one of the primary tactics he uses to deceive is doubt; he generates doubt by setting us up to question truth. He did it with Eve, and he does it with us today; only today he uses a different question.

THE DECEIVER

Genesis 2:16-17, 3:1-15, 22a (page 2, large print page 2)

Three ways to deceive:

- Lying
- · Withholding the truth
- Creating doubt about the truth
