Setting the Scene (vv. 1-2)

...For it is better that it be said to you, "Come up here," than for you to be placed lower in the presence of the prince, whom your eyes have seen. (Proverbs 25:6-7)

Understanding Humility (vv. 7-11)

Do nothing out of vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. (Phillipians 2:3)

Growing in Humility

Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though He was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied Himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men... (Phillipians 2:5-8)
