About Jesus	1. Who Jesus Is	Full God/Fully Man (John 1; Philippians 2)
	2. What Jesus Has Done	Lived, Died, Rose (1 Corinthians 15)
	3. Why Jesus Matters	
For Us		Lived the perfect life we could not.
		Died the perfect death we should have died for our sin so we might be forgiven.
		Rose into perfect resurrection life so we might have that same life in him—the very life for which we were created.
And the Cosmos		Whole creation groans, waiting to be released from the futility of the curse when Jesus returns and resurrects those who are trusting in him. (Romans 8)

- 2. **Gospel Grace is. . .** God's unique ill-deserved favor towards us in Jesus.




- 3. What we do with Gospel Grace is. . .
 - a. Embrace it—by trusting Jesus (John 11)
 - b. Live out of it—being strengthened by the grace that is ours in Jesus (2 Timothy 2:1)
 - c. Share it with a world lost in darkness—by:
 - i. **faithfully demonstrating** it through our love (John 17); and
 - ii. fearlessly declaring it as good news(Mark 16)

How Does Gospel Grace Change Us?

- 1. **Saves Us** from our sin and God's wrath, for new life in Jesus, to God's glory. **(Ephesians 2:1–10)**
- 2. Sanctifies Us positionally, progressively, and perfectly making us like Jesus. (Romans 8:28–30)
- 3. **Sets Us Free** to live out our new identity in Jesus. **(Romans 6:1–10)**




