PSALM 96:1–3

- ¹ Oh **sing** to the LORD a new song;
sing to the LORD, **all the earth!**
- ² **Sing** to the LORD, bless his name;
tell of his salvation from day to day.
- ³ **Declare** his glory among the nations,
his marvelous works among **all the peoples!**

- ⁴ **For** great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised;
he is to be feared above all gods.
- ⁵ For all the gods of the peoples are worthless
idols, but **the LORD made the heavens.**
- ⁶ Splendor and majesty are before him;
strength and beauty are in his sanctuary.

PSALM 96:7–9

- ⁷ **Ascribe** to the LORD, O families of **the peoples**,
ascribe to the LORD glory and strength!
- ⁸ **Ascribe** to the LORD **the glory due his name**;
bring an offering, and come into his courts!
- ⁹ **Worship** the LORD in the splendor of holiness;
tremble before him, **all the earth**!

¹⁰ Say among the nations,

“The LORD reigns!

Yes, the world is established;

it shall never be moved;

he will judge the peoples with equity.”

ROMANS 12:1–2

¹Therefore I exhort you, brothers and sisters,
by the mercies of God,
to **present your bodies as a sacrifice**
—alive, holy, and pleasing to God—
which is your reasonable service.

² **Do not be conformed to this present world,**
but be transformed
by the renewing of your mind,
so that you may test and approve
what is the will of God
what is good and well-pleasing and perfect.

¹⁴ Since then we have a great high priest
who has **passed through the heavens,**
Jesus, the Son of God,
let us hold fast our confession.

¹⁵ For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect **has been tempted** as we are, **yet without sin.**

ACTS 17:30–31

³⁰ The times of ignorance God overlooked, but now he commands **all people everywhere to repent,** ³¹ because he has fixed a day on which **he will judge the world in righteousness by a man whom he has appointed;** and of this he has given assurance to all by **raising him from the dead."**

¹⁹ For **the creation** waits with eager longing
for the revealing of the sons of God.

²⁰ For the creation was subjected to futility,
not willingly,
but because of him who subjected it, **in hope**

. . . **In hope**

²¹ that the creation itself will be **set free** from its bondage to corruption and obtain the freedom of the glory of the children of God.

²² For we know that the whole creation has been groaning together in the pains of childbirth until now.

NEW TESTAMENT

ROMANS 8:23

²³ And not only the creation, but we ourselves, who have the first fruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies.
