Structure of Matthew 10:5–42

10:5–15: ministry and rejection

10:16–23: persecution and family

10:24–33: suffering like the master

10:34–39: persecution and family

10:40–42: ministry and welcome



1. Christian conversion means welcoming Christ into the home of your heart (10:40)

⁴⁰ "Whoever receives you receives me, and whoever receives me receives him who sent me."



Matthew 10:11-14

¹¹ "And whatever **town** or **village** you **enter**, find out who is worthy in it and **stay there until you depart**. ¹² As you **enter the house**, greet it. ¹³ And if the house is worthy, let your peace come upon it, but if it is not worthy, let your peace return to you. ¹⁴ And if anyone will not <u>receive you</u> or <u>listen to your words</u>, shake off the dust from your feet when you leave that house or town."
