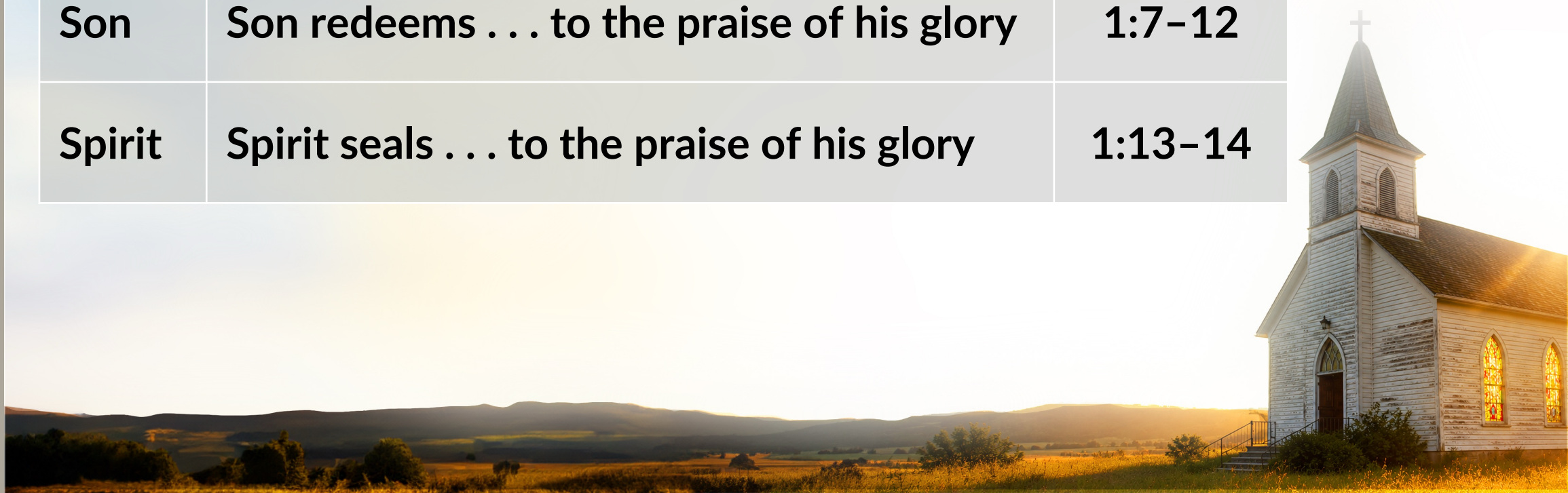

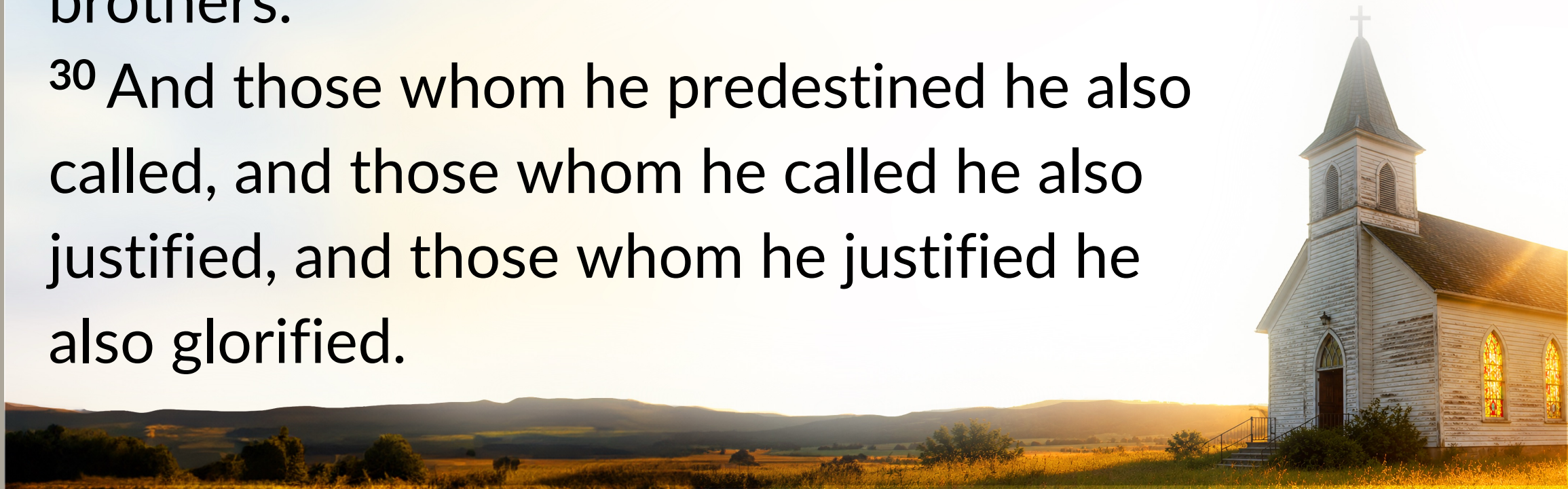


RECAP

the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to
the riches of his grace,

LEVITICUS 25:47

⁴⁷ “If a stranger or sojourner with you becomes rich, and your brother beside him becomes poor and sells himself to the stranger or sojourner with you or to a member of the stranger’s clan,

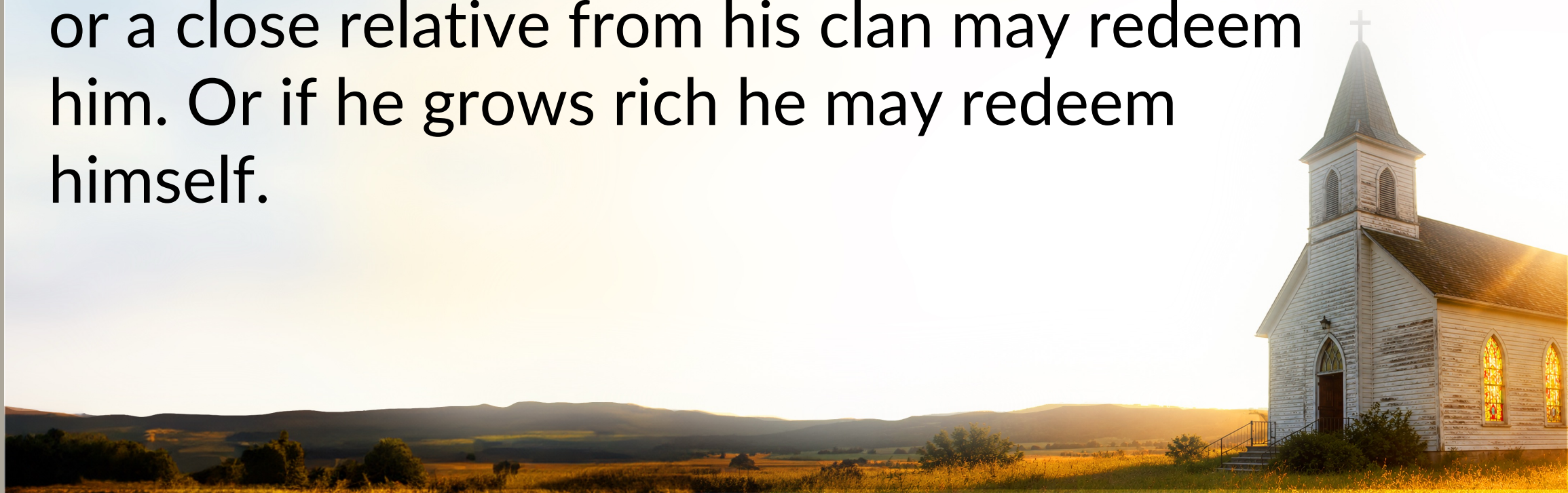




REDEMPTION

LEVITICUS 25:48–49

⁴⁸ then after he is sold he may be redeemed.
One of his brothers may redeem him,
⁴⁹ or his uncle or his cousin may redeem him,
or a close relative from his clan may redeem
him. Or if he grows rich he may redeem
himself.

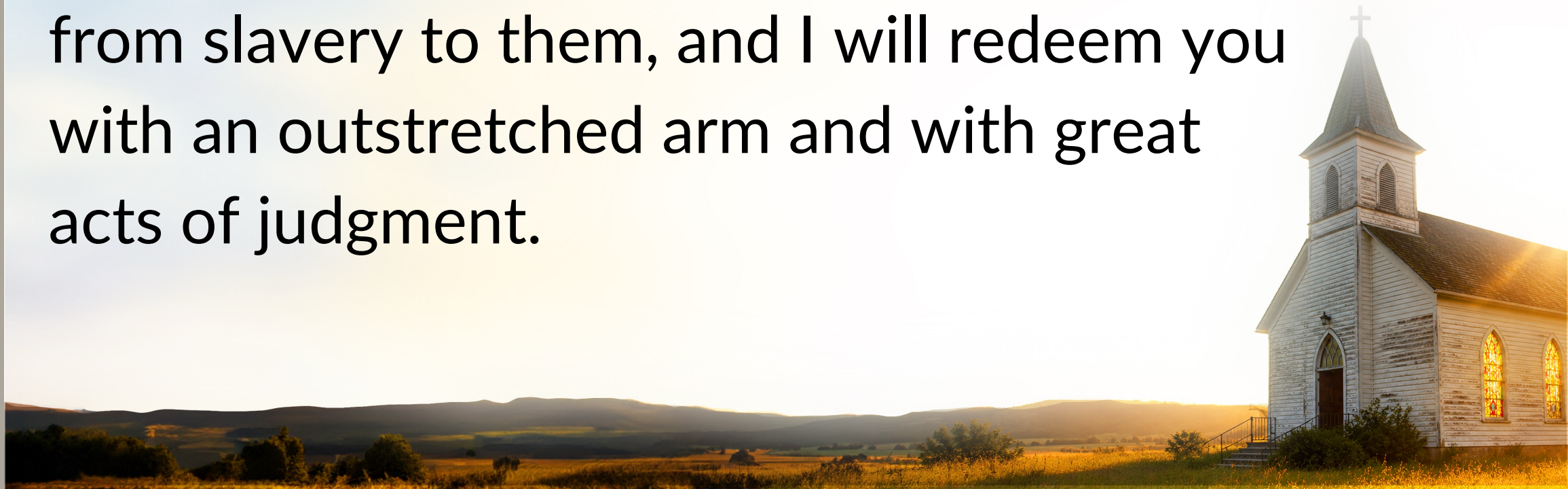




REDEMPTION

EXODUS 6:6

⁶ Say therefore to the people of Israel, 'I am the Lord, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will deliver you from slavery to them, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great acts of judgment.

EXODUS 6:7

⁷ I will take you to be my people, and I will be your God, and you shall know that I am the Lord your God, who has brought you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.

LEVITICUS 17:11

¹¹ For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it for you on the altar to make atonement for your souls, for it is the blood that makes atonement by the life.

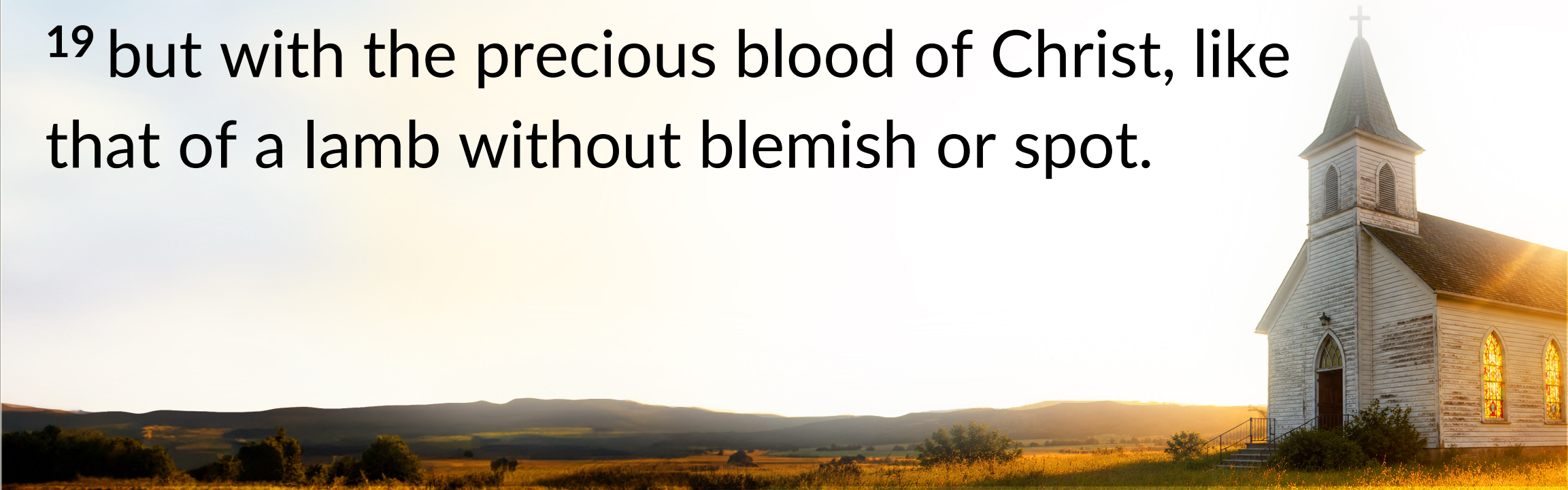




REDEMPTION

1 PETER 1:18–19

¹⁸ knowing that you were ransomed from the futile ways inherited from your forefathers, not with perishable things such as silver or gold,
¹⁹ but with the precious blood of Christ, like that of a lamb without blemish or spot.

HEBREWS 9:22

²² Indeed, under the law almost everything is purified with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sins.





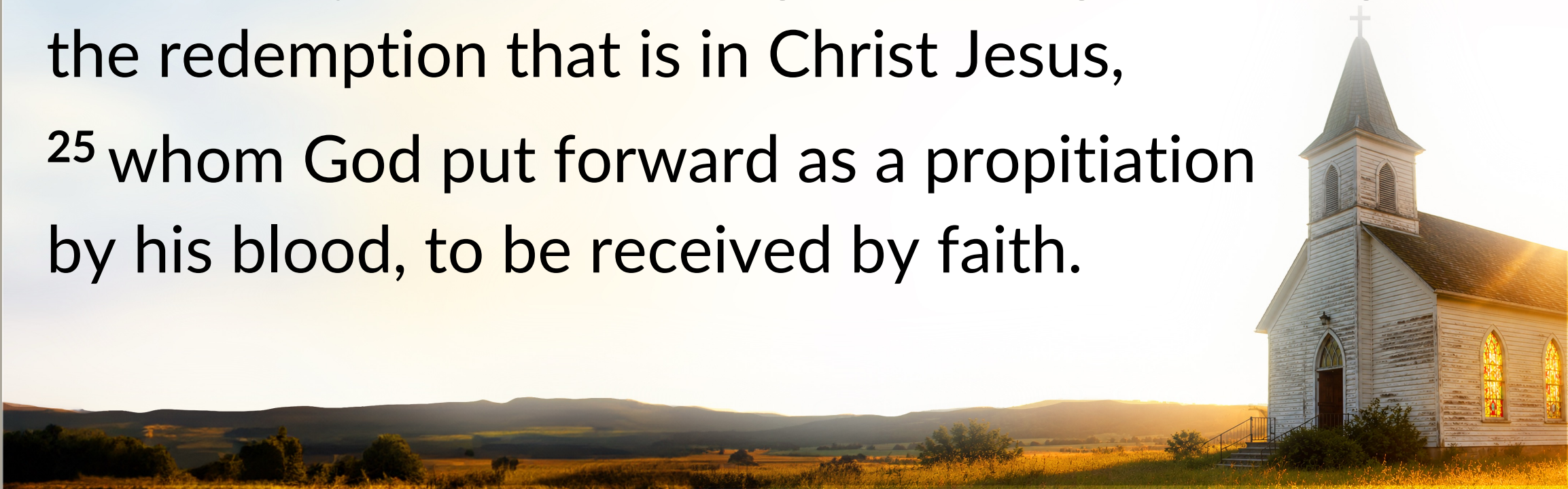
REDEMPTION

EPHESIANS 1:8 | PROVISION

⁸ which he lavished upon us, in all wisdom and insight





⁹ making known to us the mystery of his will,
according to his purpose, which he set forth in
Christ





¹⁰ as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth.

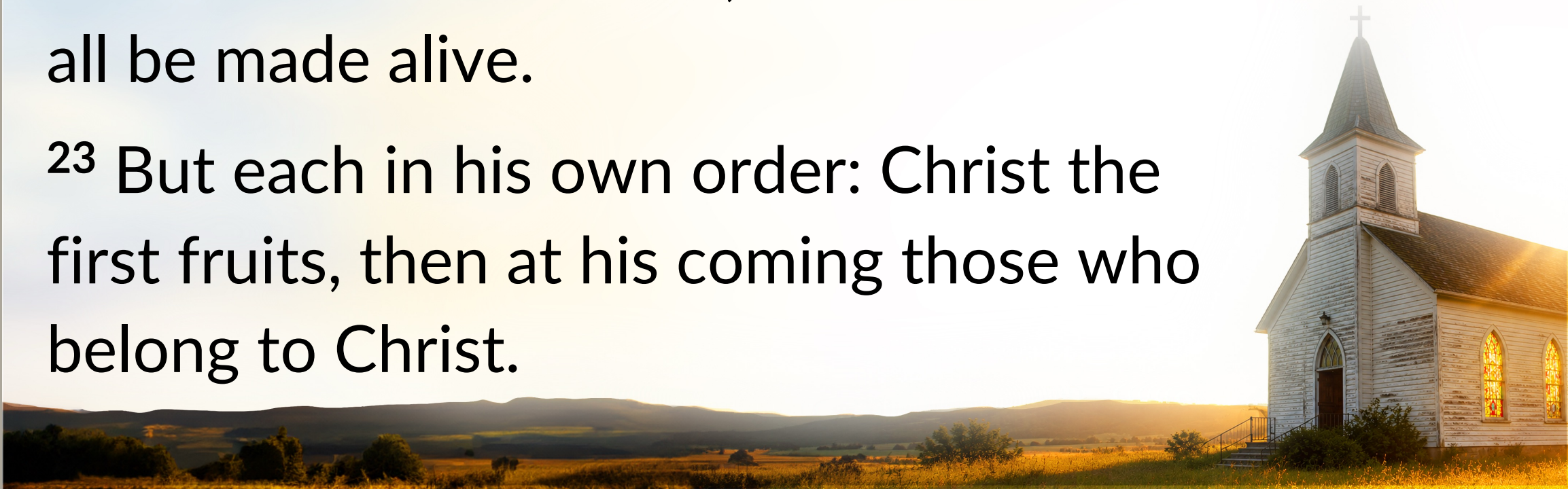




²¹ For as by a man came death, by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead.

²² For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive.

²³ But each in his own order: Christ the first fruits, then at his coming those who belong to Christ.

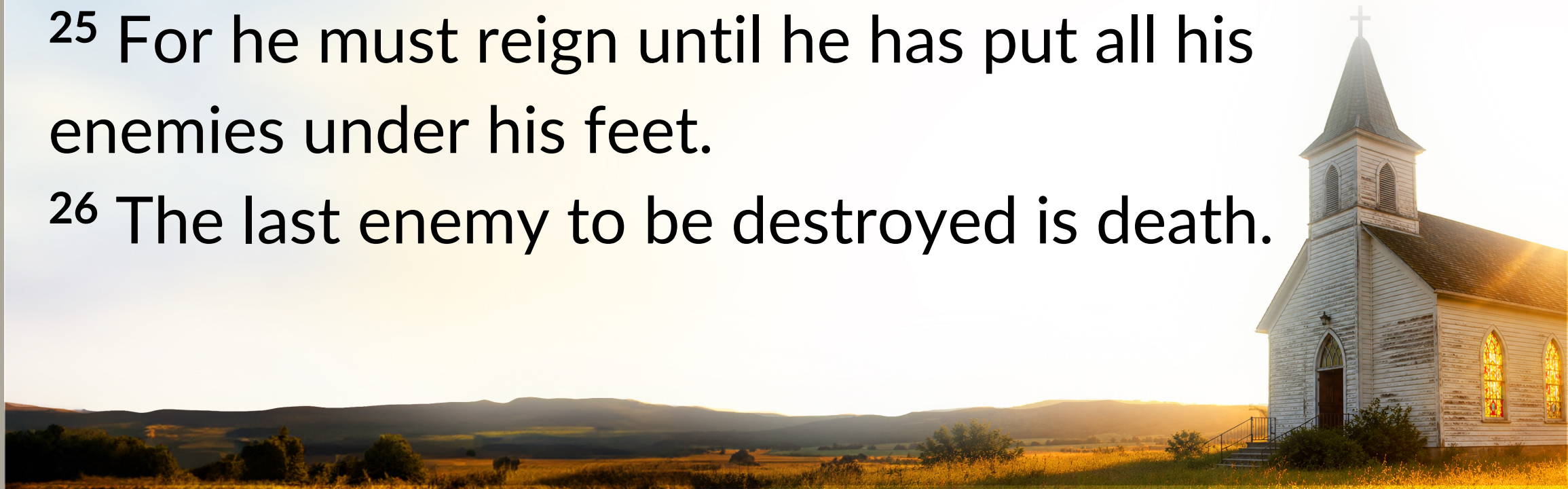




²⁴ Then comes the end, when he delivers the kingdom to God the Father after destroying every rule and every authority and power.

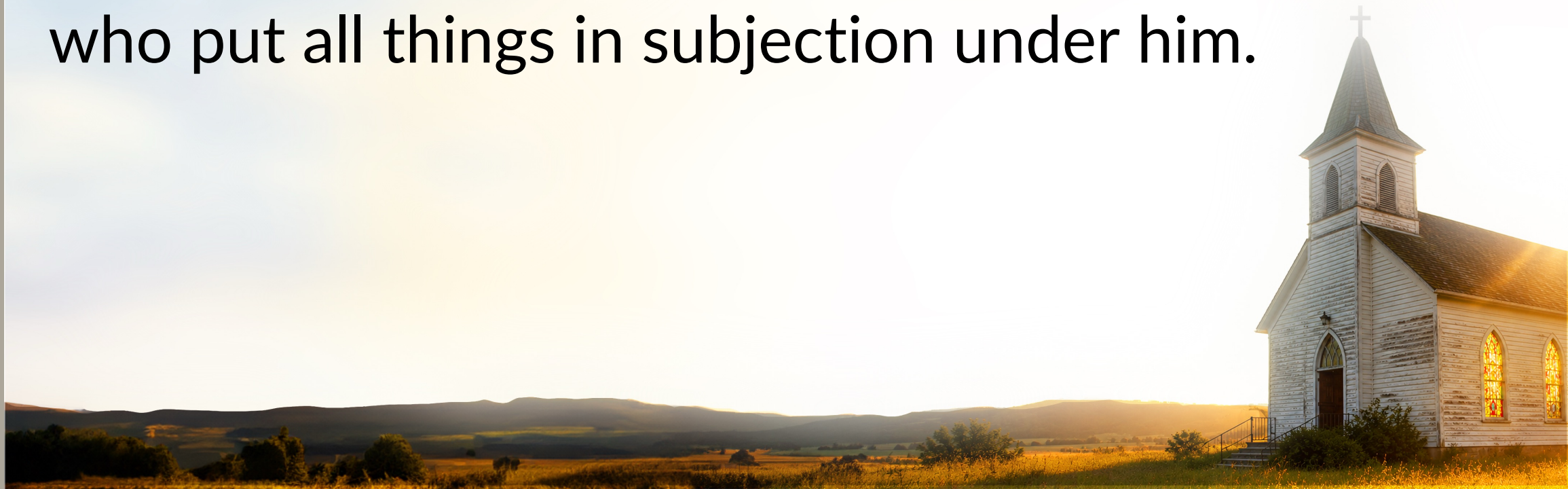
²⁵ For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet.

²⁶ The last enemy to be destroyed is death.





²⁷ For “God has put all things in subjection under his feet.” But when it says, “all things are put in subjection,” it is plain that he is excepted who put all things in subjection under him.





²⁸ When all things are subjected to him, then the Son himself will also be subjected to him who put all things in subjection under him, that God may be all in all.

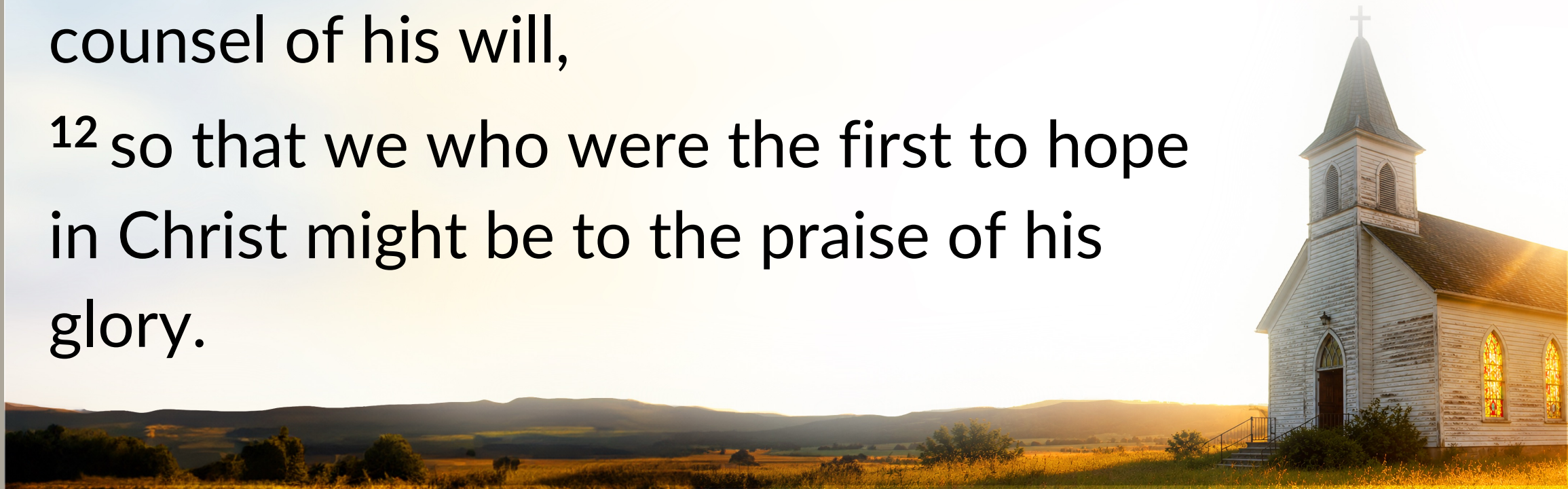

¹² so that we who were the first to hope in Christ might be to the praise of his glory.



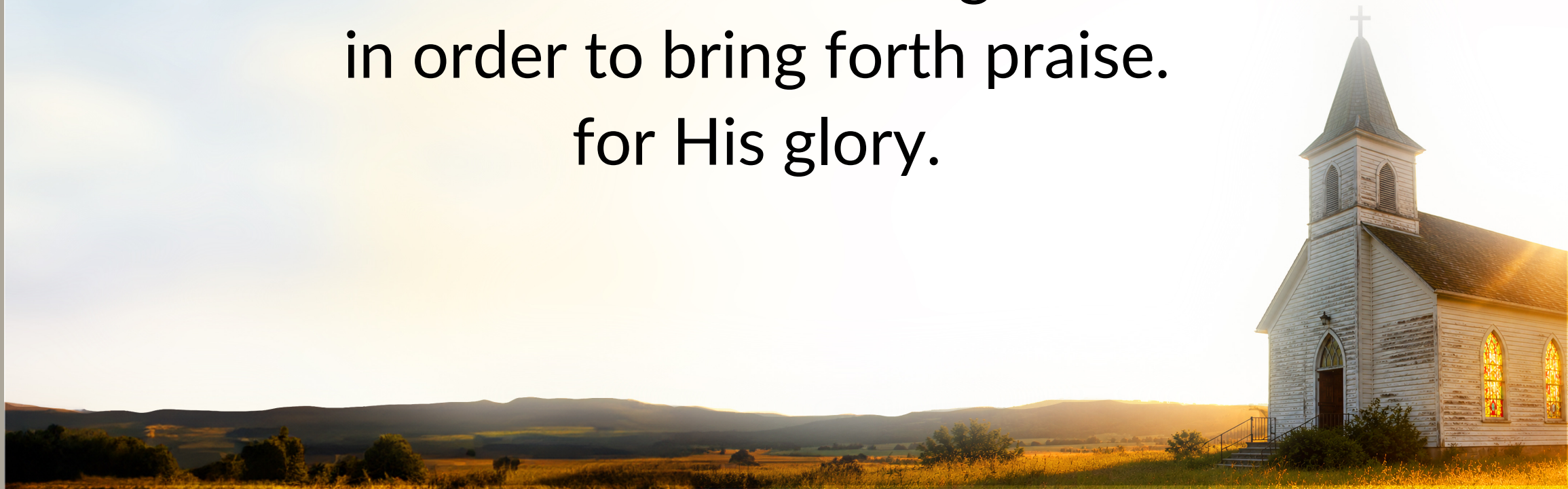

Our heavenly father has given us every spiritual blessing possible in Christ, in whom He provides redemption, revelation, and the right to be belong to God for His glory.

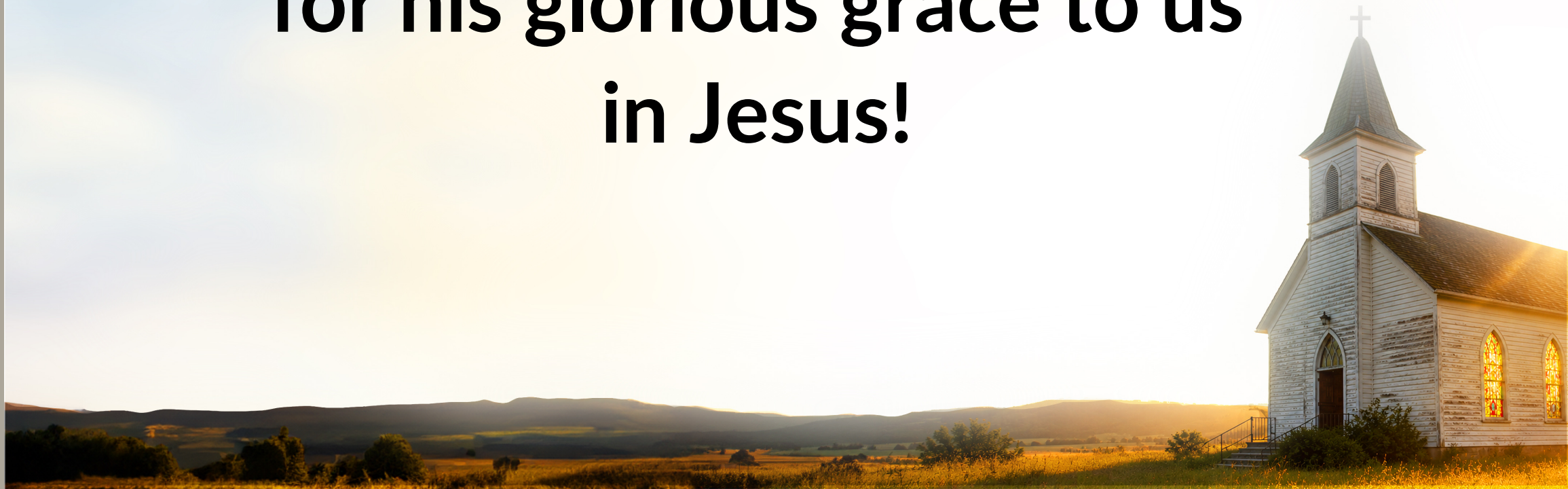
