



Parable of the 10 Virgins

Mathew 25:1-13



Mathew 25: 1-13

[1] "Then the kingdom of heaven will be like ten virgins who took their lamps and went to meet the bridegroom. [2] Five of them were foolish, and five were wise. [3] For when the foolish took their lamps, they took no oil with them, [4] but the wise took flasks of oil with their lamps. [5] As the bridegroom was delayed, they all became drowsy and slept.



But at midnight there was a cry, 'Here is the bridegroom! Come out to meet him.' [7] Then all those virgins rose and trimmed their lamps. [8] And the foolish said to the wise, 'Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.' [9] But the wise answered, saying, 'Since there will not be enough for us and for you, go rather to the dealers and buy for yourselves.'




[10] And while they were going to buy, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the marriage feast, and the door was shut. [11] Afterward the other virgins came also, saying, 'Lord, lord, open to us.' [12] But he answered, 'Truly, I say to you, I do not know you.' [13] Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour. (ESV)



Book of Daniel

Chapters 2, 7, and 8

Daniel prophesied Alexander the Great coming 200 years before he was born.





Why did God give Daniel the prophecy?

- 1. For God's glory to be revealed
- 2. To give us reason and evidence to believe God



This parable gives the immediate best insight as to why Jesus shared the prophecies in Mathew 24.

What is important. Not, What is religious.



2 Timothy 3:16–17

[16] All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, [17] that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work. (ESV)



Teaching and reproof – Beware false prophets

The correction – do not fade away from the things, I have taught you. Persevere.

Perseverance will train you in righteousness



Romans 5: 1-5

[1] Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. [2] Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God...



...Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, [4] and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, [5] and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been **poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit** who has been given to us. (ESV)
