The Display of Godly Character

(1 Peter 3:8)

- Attitudes are foundational to our actions
- The unbeliever is put on notice that <u>something different is</u> <u>happening</u>

Restraint Informed by Hope

(1 Peter 3:10-17)

- Reflecting <u>Divine forbearance</u>
 - Returning good for evil is Divine
 - Remembering that we were once <u>God's enemies</u>
- Pursuing <u>enlightened self-interest</u>
 - Don't focus on the <u>hardship of the present</u>, but on the <u>blessings in the future</u>
- God's way is <u>eternally better</u> than the alternative

Jesus is the Last Word

(1 Peter 3:18-22)

- The greatest good was accomplished through Jesus' suffering.
 Ours won't be wasted either.
- In the end, Jesus is victorious. We take courage in His triumph and vindication
