Personal Reflection

1. Have you ever felt the weight of guilt or conviction described in this Psalm? What did you do in response?
2. What are ways that you personally try to cover up or avoid dealing with sin?
3. In what areas of your life do you need to obey God today rather than resisting like “the mule”?

Evangelism Practice

4. Do you have a clear “game plan” for sharing the gospel? How could Psalm 32 be part of it?
5. Think of someone in your life who may be experiencing conviction. How might you enter a gospel conversation with them?
6. What “hooks” or everyday moments could you use to bring up spiritual conversations (e.g., mentioning church, personal testimony)?

Gospel Clarity

7. How well can you articulate the meaning of forgiveness in biblical terms (e.g., substitution, atonement, transfer of guilt)?
8. How does the image of Christ bearing our iniquity personally impact your faith?
9. What’s one part of the gospel message (e.g., sin, grace, repentance, faith) you’d like to understand or communicate more clearly?
