Sermons for Toddlers



• Objectives •

 for the kids to know that God made them fearfully and wonderfully

 Pray that the kids will know in their hearts that they are wonderfully made & loved by God.

 Make a reminder of today's outline

• Supplies Needed •

- Treasure box
- Tube
- Play-dough
- Mirror

Craft option 1

- Yellow, black, brown & orange wool
- A pair of scissors (keep these out of the reach of the children)
- Craft glue
- Crayons

Craft Option 2

I2I wonderfully made

Step1: Circle Up

2 minutes

Sing: Let's make a circle, a circle, a circle
Let's make a circle round like a ball

Step 2: Who came to church today?

5 minutes

SONG and Peep tube:

Where is Noah (NAME), where is Noah?
Did he come? (repeat if few kids)
Come to church today? (repeat if few kids)
Here I am, here I am, and how do you do?

(TRY TO GET THEM TO RESPOND) – Look each child in the eye, and let them know how glad you are that they are here today.

Where is Jesus, where is Jesus
Is he here, is he here?
Is he in your heart, is he in your heart?
Yes he is, yes he is and I love him too.

Step 3: Worship & Ministry

10 minutes

Songs:

Ask the kids to sit quietly and listen to God's voice (just for a minute)
Ask if anyone needs prayer

Step 4: Sermon

10 minutes

Let's see what is in today's treasure chest! Who wants to know? Remember we only open the treasure chest when everyone is sitting down quietly. Now let's open the chest!

Take out some play dough. Today we are learning about how God made people. After he had made all the stars, and plants and animals, he took some clay and started to form something amazing.

Start forming a person, and let the little ones guess what you are making. Talk about how God made Adam and Eve to look a little bit like him.

- Printed activity pages
- Poster paints
- Wipes

Do you know that when God made Adam and Eve, he was already thinking about another amazing person he was going to make, I have a picture of that person here

Take a mirror out of the treasure chest, and let each child look, as you tell them, God made you so special! He made us all so different, but we can all do amazing things.

Have the kids do these things with you to show how special their bodies are:

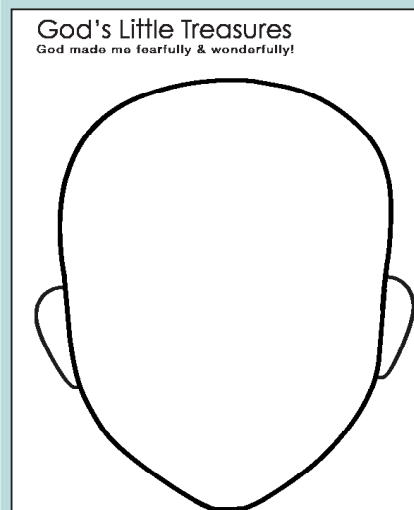
- Clap your hands
- Put your hands on your head
- Blink your eyes
- Wiggle your nose
- Shake your legs
- Sit on your bum
- Crawl
- Move your head
- Sing

End with a time of prayer – say each child’s name, and let all the kids say, “Thank you Jesus for making _____ so special. Please bless _____.”

Step 5: Craft

10 minutes



Option 1:

Give each child a coloring page. Ask them:

- How many eyes did God give you? Let’s draw 2 eyes.
- How many ears did God give you? Let’s draw 2 ears.
- How many noses did God give you? Let’s draw a nose.
- What does your mouth look like? Let’s draw it smiling.
- What kind of hair did God give you? Help them to paste hair onto their picture to look like their hair

Option 2:

Give each child a blue circle or paper plate. Gently paint their hands with green poster paint, and have them press them onto the circle. Then write, ““God made the earth & he made me!”

Step 6: Ending Song

Sing Alligator Goodbye (Hillsong Kids) and close in prayer.
