Day 1: Big Idea: God is the loving King, and His ways are best

Genesis 1 - Creation, Exodus 19-20 - 10 commandments

Day 2: Big Idea: Choosing our own way hurts everyone

Genesis 3 - the fall, Judges 2:10–19 – Everyone Did What Was Right in Their Own Eyes

DAY 1 TEACHING: GOD IS LOVE. GOD IS KING. HIS WAYS ARE BEST

Genesis 1, Exodus 19–20

Core Truth to Say Clearly

God is Love.
God is King.
And His ways are best.

Teaching Flow

1. God Is Love (Genesis 1)

Before there was anything, there was God.

He did not create because He needed us.
He created because He is love.

When God made the world, He said:

“It is good.”

When He made people, He said:

“Very good.”

You were not an accident.
You were made on purpose.
By a loving God.

2. God Is King

God is not just loving.
He is also King.

A king rules.
A king decides what is right.
A king sets the way things work.

But God is not a harsh king.

He rescued His people first (Exodus 19),
then gave them commandments (Exodus 20).

Rescue first.

Relationship first.
Then rules.

Because:
Love leads.

3. Why His Ways Are Best

The Ten Commandments weren't to control
people.

They were to protect them.

When God says:

- Don't lie
- Don't steal
- Don't hurt

He's saying:

“This is how life works best.”

Because the loving King knows how life works.

DAY 2 TEACHING: SIN SEPARATES US FROM OUR LOVING KING

Genesis 3, Judges 2:10–19

Core Truth to Say Clearly

Sin has a cause and a consequence.

The cause: choosing our way instead of God's.
The consequence: separation from God.

Teaching Flow

1. The Cause of Sin (Genesis 3)

The serpent whispered:

“Did God really say?”

The lie was:
God is not good.
God is holding out on you.

Adam and Eve chose their own way.

Sin is not just breaking a rule.

Sin is pushing God off the throne and saying:
“I want to be king.”

2. The Consequence of Sin

Immediately:

- They hid.
- They felt shame.
- They were afraid.

Before sin, they walked with God.
After sin, they hid from Him.

That's separation.

Sin separates us from the loving King.

And separation leads to:

- Fear
- Broken relationships
- Hurt

Judges says:
“Everyone did what was right in their own eyes.”

When everyone is their own king,
everything falls apart.

Say Clearly

Because of sin, we are separated from God.

And we cannot fix that on our own.

DAY 3 TEACHING: WE NEED RESCUE – AND GOD PROMISED ONE

Isaiah 53, Jeremiah 31:31–34

Core Truth to Say Clearly

Rules show us what's wrong.
They cannot remove sin.

We need rescue.

Teaching Flow

1. The Law Shows, But Doesn't Save

God's commands are good.

But they show us something:
We don't always obey.

It's like a mirror.
It shows dirt.
It cannot wash it away.

2. God Promised a Rescuer (Isaiah 53)

Isaiah said:

"He was pierced for our transgressions."

That means:
He would suffer.
Not for His sin.
For ours.

3. A New Covenant (Jeremiah 31)

God promised:

"I will forgive their wickedness."
"I will remember their sins no more."
"I will write my law on their hearts."

Not just better behaviour.

New hearts.

Say Clearly

God is Love.
So He made a way.

The loving King promised a rescuer.

DAY 4 TEACHING:

JESUS DEFEATED SIN THROUGH HIS DEATH AND RESURRECTION

Luke 23

Tone: Gentle. Clear. Certain.

Repeat

“Jesus defeated sin.”

Core Truth to Say Clearly

Jesus took the punishment for sin.
And He defeated it.

Teaching Flow

Jesus never sinned.

But He was arrested.
Beaten.
Crucified.

On the cross He said:
“Father, forgive them.”

The consequence of sin is separation from God.

Jesus stepped into that separation.

He took:

- The blame
- The punishment
- The cost

He died.

But the story does not end there.

On the third day — He rose.

That means:
Sin did not win.
Death did not win.
Jesus defeated sin.

The loving King won the victory.

DAY 5 TEACHING: WE HAVE A CHOICE — AND JESUS MAKES US NEW

Luke 19:1–10, 2 Corinthians
5:17

Core Truth to Say Clearly

We must choose.

Repent.
Believe.
Follow.

Teaching Flow

1. Zacchaeus – A Changed Man

Zacchaeus cheated people.

But when he met Jesus,
he changed.

He gave money back.
He became generous.

Why?

Because grace changes hearts.

2. Our Choice

The Bible says:

Repent — that means turn around.
Stop being your own king.

Believe — trust Jesus as King and Saviour.

We all get to choose.

3. What Happens When We Believe?

When we repent and believe:

We become:

- Sons and daughters of God
- Citizens of heaven
- Ambassadors of the Kingdom

God becomes our Father.
Heaven becomes our home.
We represent Jesus wherever we go.

And we are made new from the inside out.

“If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation.”

Not improved.
New.

Final Gospel Summary (End of Week Moment)

Say slowly:

God is Love.
God is King.
Sin separates us from Him.
Jesus defeated sin through His death and resurrection.
We can choose to repent and believe.
And when we do,
we become sons and daughters of God,
citizens of heaven,
and ambassadors of His Kingdom.
