• Objectives •



for the kids to know that God made the earth & He made them



Pray that the kids will know in their hearts that they are wonderfully made & loved by God.



Make a craft to remind them of our creator God

• Supplies Needed •

- Treasure box
- Tube
- Globe
- Spray bottle with water
- Seeds, wood & bark
- Toy animals, birds and fish
- Person figurine

Craft option 1

- Paper plates (1 per child)
- Dot paint markers
- Markers

Craft Option2

Step1: Circle Up

2 minutes

Sing: Let's make a circle, a circle, a circle
Let's make a circle round like a ball

Step 2: Who came to church today?

5 minutes

SONG and Peep tube:

Where is Noah (NAME), where is Noah?
Did he come? (repeat if few kids)
Come to church today? (repeat if few kids)
Here I am, here I am, and how do you do?

(TRY TO GET THEM TO RESPOND) – Look each child in the eye, and let them know how glad you are that they are here today.

Where is Jesus, where is Jesus
Is he here, is he here?
Is he in your heart, is he in your heart?
Yes he is, yes he is and I love him too.

Step 3: Worship & Ministry

10 minutes

Songs:

Ask the kids to sit quietly and listen to God's voice (just for a minute)
Ask if anyone needs prayer

Step 4: Sermon

10 minutes

Let's see what is in today's treasure chest! Who wants to know? Remember we only open the treasure chest when everyone is sitting down quietly. Now let's open the chest!

Take out a small globe. Today we are learning about how God made the world! Let's all cover our eyes – that's what the world looked like before God created it – it was just dark.


Now open your eyes – God made light!

Take a spray bottle out of the treasure chest, and gently spray the kids – Then God made water. Who knows where the water is found? ... that's right – in the sea and rivers.

- Green poster paint
- Green markers.
- Blue card circle or paper plate for each child.

• Notes •

Take some seeds, wood and bark out of the treasure chest. Pass them around and let the kids feel them. God made all the beautiful plants and seeds in the world, so that we'd have shade and food. Isn't he amazing?



Take some toy animals, fish and birds out of the treasure box and pass them around. Let the kids make the noises that they make.

Look at all the beautiful creatures that God made for us!

Pull out a person figurine. God made humans, and he made you. Point to the different parts of the person – God made our eyes, ears, nose etc. Pray for the kids and thank God for their uniqueness, colour eyes, hair, their personalities, gifts etc.

Step 5: Craft

10 minutes

Option 1:

Give each child a paper plate, and let them use green and blue dot markers to create a globe pattern. Around the edge of the plate, write: "God made the earth & he made me!"

Option 2:

Give each child a blue circle or paper plate. Gently paint their hands with green poster paint, and have them press them onto the circle. Then write, "God made the earth & he made me!"

Step 6: Ending Song

Sing Alligator Goodbye (Hillsong Kids) and close in prayer.
