## I9| Jesus is my healer

### Step1: Circle Up

2 minutes

Sing: Let's make a circle, a circle, a circle  
Let's make a circle round like a ball

### Step 2: Who came to church today?

5 minutes

SONG and Peep tube:

Where is Noah (NAME), where is Noah?  
Did he come? (repeat if few kids)  
Come to church today? (repeat if few kids)  
Here I am, here I am, and how do you do?

(TRY TO GET THEM TO RESPOND) – Look each child in the eye, and let them know how glad you are that they are here today.

Where is Jesus, where is Jesus  
Is he here, is he here?  
Is he in your heart, is he in your heart?  
Yes he is, yes he is and I love him too.

### Step 3: Worship & Ministry

10 minutes

Songs:

Ask the kids to sit quietly and listen to God's voice (just for a minute)  
Ask if anyone needs prayer

### Step 4: Sermon

10 minutes

- Let's see what is in today's treasure chest! Who wants to know? Remember we only open the treasure chest when everyone is sitting down quietly. Now let's open the chest!
- Take out a teddy bear that has bandages on its arms and legs. Oh no, look at my Teddy, he's so sick! What should we do? Get ideas from the kids – That's right – when someone is sick, we can pray. But how do we pray?
- There is something in our treasure chest that will help us to learn. Take out a cup with some coins and the clothes of a beggar. Dress up one of the kids and tell the story of Peter and John at the temple gate from Acts 3:1-10. Jesus is the healer, so all we have to do is ask him to do the healing.

- Pre-cut lame men
- 1/4 inch strips of colored paper (2x2" and 2x4")
- Glue Stick

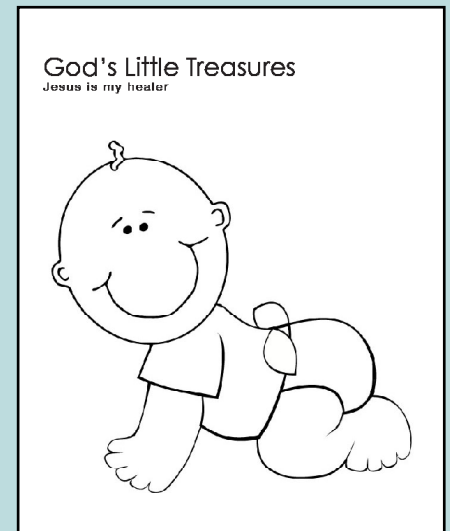
- Let's practice laying hands on the teddy bear. Thank you Jesus that you're the healer. Please heal the teddy. In Jesus name. Amen.
- Now give each child a chance to pray, and then ask if there are any children who need healing. Let them pray for each other.

### Step 5: Craft

10 minutes

#### Option 1:

- Give each child a coloring page, and have them stick a band-aid onto the baby, before coloring in the picture.
- Remind them that when we are sick, Jesus can heal us.



#### Option 2:

- Give each child a pre-cut lame man, and 4 x 1/4 inch wide strips of colored paper.
- Help them to fold the paper (as seen below) and glue arms and legs onto the lame man.



### Step 6: Ending Song

Sing Alligator Goodbye (Hillsong Kids) and close in prayer.
