

- Tube
- A necklace made from a paper heart and ribbon for each child.
- A children's Bible that contains the story of Ruth.

Craft option 1

- Activity pages
- Red poster paint
- Toilet paper tubes.

Step1: Circle Up

Sing: Let's make a circle, a circle, a circle Let's make a circle round like a ball

Step 2: Who came to church today?

SONG and Peep tube:

Where is Noah (NAME), where is Noah?

Did he come? (repeat if few kids)

Come to church today? (repeat if few kids)

Here I am, here I am, and how do you do?

(TRY TO GET THEM TO RESPOND) – Look each child in the eye, and let them know how glad you are that they are here today.

Where is Jesus, where is Jesus Is he here, is he here? Is he in your heart, is he in your heart? Yes he is, yes he is and I love him too.

Step 3: Worship & Ministry

10 minutes

Songs:

Ask the kids to sit quietly and listen to God's voice (just for a minute) Ask if anyone needs prayer

Step 4: Sermon 10 minutes

- Let's see what is in today's treasure chest! Who wants to know? Remember
 we only open the treasure chest when everyone is sitting down quietly. Now
 let's open the chest!
- Peep inside.... Guess what? I have something for each one of you, just because I love you. Pull out necklaces, made with ribbon and a card-stock heart. Give one to each child.
- Hearts remind us of love, and Jesus says that we should love each other.
- Give each child a hug. Now take out a children's Bible and tell the story of Ruth. She loved her friend Naomi so much, that she left her home and family to look after her. She shared all the food that she found with her, and

God rewarded her by looking after her. Isn't it wonderful to show love to people? When we play, we can show love by sharing our toys. We can also say kind things.

- Say something kind and encouraging to each child, and let the bigger children say something kind to the little ones.
- Now we're going to ask Jesus to fill us up with his love, so that we can love all the people we see this week.
- Show the kids how to make themselves like a cup that God can pour his love into, by lifting their hands. Pray that Jesus will fill them up with his love.

Step 5: Craft 10 minutes

Option 1:

- Give each child an activity page, and a stamp created by pinching a toilet paper tube into a heart shape.
- Allow them to dip the end of the tube into red poster paint, and


then press it onto the activity page to make a number of hearts.

Remind them that Jesus wants us to love each other.



Option 2:
