May 27, 2018 BUILDING SUCCESSFUL RELATIONSHIPS - Part 2 "Encouragement"

Everyone, and every relationship, needs encouraging.

Hebrews 3:13 (NIV): "But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called Today, so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness."

And there's nothing the devil loves more than to get us <u>doubting</u> ourselves and God's work in our lives.

"encourage" - to give courage

God created us for relationships, and one of the gifts of relationships is the ability to give <u>courage</u> to others as they face challenges in their lives.

Hebrews 10:24-25 (NIV): "²⁴And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. ²⁵Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching."

The Bible is calling us to make the most of these opportunities, because none of us is promised <u>tomorrow</u>, so "encourage one another" *today*!

Encouragement, giving courage to another, helps them overcome "sin's deceitfulness" in their lives.

Jesus: "'For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.'" (**John 3:16** NIV) **Jesus**: "'...be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.'" (**Matthew 28:20** NLT)

1 John 4:4 (ESV): "...he who is in you is greater than he who is in the world." **The LORD**: "'no weapon forged against you will prevail...'" (**Isaiah 54:17** NIV) **Romans 8:31** (NLT): "...If God is for us, who can ever be against us?"

<u>Disciples</u> of Jesus Christ are called to share his love and encouragement with those around us.

1 Thessalonians 5:9-11 (NLT): "⁹For God chose to save us through our Lord Jesus Christ, not to pour out his anger on us. ¹⁰Christ died for us so that, whether we are dead

or alive when he returns, we can live with him forever. ¹¹So encourage each other and build each other up, just as you are already doing."

People are drawn to those who believe in them.

Giving Encouragement:

- 1. Encouragement needs to be <u>real</u>.
- 2. Encouragement needs to be regular.
- 3. Encouragement needs to be specific.
