The problem is what makes us happy, at least for a while, may not really be ____ for us.

We're not really *finding* happiness but finding a _____ *from* our *unhappiness*.

The results of studies suggest that focusing on being happy may, in fact, make us more ____ of how unhappy we are rather than helping us become more happy.

This is what David meant when he spoke of the **happiness** of the person whom God accepts as righteous, apart from anything that person does: '**Happy** are those whose wrongs are forgiven, whose sins are pardoned! **Happy** is the person whose sins the Lord will not keep account of!' (emphasis added)

-Romans 4:6-8 (TEV)

David says the same thing when he speaks of the

blessedness of the one to whom God credits righteousness apart from works: '**Blessed** are those whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered. **Blessed** is the one whose sin the Lord will never count against them.' (emphasis added) —Romans 4:6-8 (NIV11)

"Happiness" or "blessedness" is the result of ____ God's forgiveness, and therefore being made right with God.
