Theme of Romans: Romans 1:16,17

Romans is the clearest, most in-depth look at the Gospel in all of scripture. But and here is where most people miss the boat, the book is not just to explain the Gospel to unbelievers; it's primarily a book written to Christians to take Christians deeper into the Gospel.

Truth One

Paul, a servant of Christ Jesus, called to be an apostle and set apart for the gospel of God— the gospel he promised beforehand through his prophets in the Holy Scriptures regarding his Son, who as to his earthly life was a descendant of David, and who through the Spirit of holiness was appointed the Son of God in power[b] by his resurrection from the dead: Jesus Christ our Lord.

—*Romans 1:1-4*

You are **Called** by God.

We love Him because He loved us first.

But God showed His love to us. While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

You have not chosen Me; I have chosen you.

Truth Three

I long to see you so that I may impart to you some spiritual gift to make you strong—that is, that you and I may be mutually encouraged by each other's faith.
