## Christ - Like Qualities:

- **Loving** – loving people well
- **Joyful** – much deeper than happiness
- **Peaceful** – living with peace even in difficult circumstances
- **Peacemaker** – spreading calm by your presence
- **Courageous** – moving forward on your mission in the face of opposition
- **Wise** – synthesizing information to make good decisions
- **Merciful** – giving others grace wherever possible
- **Kind** – treating others with respect and goodness
- **Slow to speak** – listening more than talking
- **Resilient** – returning to your mission any time tough things try to move you off course
- **Perceptive** – seeing behind the words and actions of others
- **Forgiving** – able to let offenses go
- **Obedient** – living your life before an audience of One – God, following all His directions
- **Full of faith** – relying on God to be and do what He says He will do
- **Faithful** – someone others can count on
- **Humble** – thinking of others more than yourself (not thinking less of yourself, but thinking of yourself less)
- **Generous** – freely giving what you have to those who are able to receive it
- **Self-controlled** – not ruled by your appetites
- **Passionate** – putting your whole heart into your mission
- **Perseverant** – not letting circumstances or distractions dissuade you from your mission
- **Godly** – constantly mindful of God’s perspective on your life and mission
- **Integrity** – being the same regardless of who is (or isn’t) watching
- **Prayerful** – regularly communicating personally with God
- **Truthful** – honest, having nothing to hide
- **Sacrificial** – willing to give yourself, when God so directs, even when it hurts
- **Righteous** – doing everything such that God would approve
- **Hopeful** – mindful of heavenly eternity even when things look dark
- **Fully alive** – living each moment to the full – physically, emotionally, spiritually
- **Growing** – always increasing in maturity, wisdom, skills
- **Thankful** – acknowledging to God and others the gifts you receive
- **Diligent** – investing your time and other resources to get a good return
- **Excellent** – doing all that you do to the very best of your ability
- **Jealous** – fighting against injustice when those close to you are in danger or harmed
- **Intimate** – willing and able to share the deepest parts of you with select others
- **Friendly** – willing and able to enter into and participate in other people’s worlds
- **Servant minded** – looking more for what you can give than what you can get
- **Self-aware** – conscious of what you think, know, and feel
- **Confident** – absolutely certain of who you are and what your mission is
- **Patient** – invested fully in the now while allowing God to direct future results
- **Flexible** – able to adjust tactics without changing mission
- **Unafraid** – not moved by fear in any dimension
- **Valuable** – making other’s lives better by your involvement with them
- **Self-protective** – risking yourself only when others can truly benefit

- **Inspiring** – living in such a way that others are lifted up
- **Spirit-filled** – allowing the Holy Spirit inside you to do what He wills with you

- **Nurturing** – caring tenderly for those who are hurting or broken
