

Reflecting the Lord's Glory

II Corinthians 3:7-18



Main Point:

When we turn to Jesus Christ, the veil is removed, and we reflect His Glory to a watching world.



**'Glory (doxa)' = splendor,
brightness**



**“We reflect the Lord’s glory” = we
can only reflect the Lord Jesus’
glory thru the indwelling Spirit of
Christ = the Life of Christ in me.**

Galatians 2:20



1. The Law which brought death & condemnation came with God's glory, but the ministry of the indwelling Spirit which brings righteousness & freedom is much more glorious!
verses 7-11

2. Moses wore a veil to prevent the Israelites from seeing God's glory (which was passing away – fading)

verse 13



Exodus 34:29-35



**3. A veil remains on their minds still
when reading the old covenant (which
glory is passing away).**

verse 14



**4. Only when we turn to the Lord
Jesus Christ is the veil that dulls
our minds taken away.**

verse 14



5. We reflect the Lord's glory with boldness because it comes from the indwelling Spirit of the Lord!

verse 12 & 18



***As we interact with people they should see the Lord's glory... the reflection of Jesus Christ – His righteousness, peace, forgiveness, freedom, joy, love – the fruit of the Spirit!**
